- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-5-704(a), concerning the payment of claims to covered public employees, their designated beneficiaries, or their survivors, is amended to read as follows:
- (a)(1)(A) The state shall pay to the designated beneficiary or, if there is no designated beneficiary, then to the surviving spouse or surviving children under the age of twenty-two (22) years of age or, if there is no surviving spouse or surviving children under the age of twenty-two (22) years of age, then to the surviving children twenty-two (22) years of age or older or to the surviving parents of any a covered public employee who is killed in the official line of duty, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).
- if there is no designated beneficiary, then to the surviving spouse or
 surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age or, if there is no
 surviving spouse or surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age,
 then to the surviving children twenty-two (22) years of age or older or to
 the surviving parents of a police officer who is killed in the official line
 of duty the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)

33	(2) In addition to the benefits provided for in subdivision		
34	(b)(1) of this section, the state shall pay the additional sum of fifty		
35	thousand dollars (\$50,000) to the designated beneficiary, surviving spouse,		
36	or surviving children under twenty-two (22) years of age of a police officer:		

1	(A) Who was wearing a bulletproof vest approved by the		
2	Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police; and		
3	(B) Whose death occurred:

7	(c)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, the		
8	benefits shall be paid totally from state funds appropriated for these		
9	benefits. The funds shall not be reimbursed by a transfer or charging the		
10	funds against any state funds allocated for turnback to cities or counties or		
11	distributed to any other state department agency fund account other than the		
12	Arkansas State Claims Commission fund accounts and the Miscellaneous		
13	Revolving Fund Account.		
14	(2)(A) Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) of the one		
15	hundred fifty thousand dollars ($$150,000$) provided in subdivision (c)(1) of		
16	this section shall be paid by the appropriate state department agency fund		
17	account.		
18	(B) The appropriate state department agency shall transfer		
19	the necessary funds to the Arkansas State Claims Commission fund accounts for		
20	payment.		
21	(d) The additional benefits provided in this section shall be paid to		
22	the designated beneficiary, surviving spouse, surviving children, or		
23	surviving parents in three (3) equal annual payments, the first of which		
24	shall be paid in July of the next fiscal year after the date of the original		
25	order of the Arkansas State Claims Commission establishing entitlement to		
26	additional payments and annually thereafter.		
27	(e) Determination of eligibility for the additional payments provided		
28	$\underline{\text{for}}$ in this section shall be made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission in		
29	accordance with Arkansas State Claims Commission rules and procedures.
