(b)(1) If credible evidence of a violation of subdivisions $\frac{(a)(1)-(3)}{(a)}$ 13 14 (a)(1)-(4) is presented to the president, vice president, or secretary of a 15 school district board of directors, a majority of the members of the school 16 district board of directors shall: 17 (A) Vote on whether to appoint an independent investigator to investigate the credible evidence presented; and 18 19 (B) Hold a hearing on the existence of a vacancy on the school district board of directors. 20 21 22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-629(a)(1) and (a)(2)(A), concerning 23 the training of school board members, is amended to read as follows: 24 (a)(1)(A) A member of a local school district board of directors who 25 has served on the board of directors for twelve (12) or more consecutive 26 months shall obtain no less than six (6) hours of training and instruction by 27 December 31 of each calendar year. (B) A member of a school district board of directors 28 29 elected for an initial or non-continuous term shall obtain: 30 (i) No less than nine (9) hours of training and 31 instruction by December 31 of the calendar year following the year in which 32 the member is elected; and 33 (ii) The training or instruction under subdivision 34 (a)(2)(B) (a)(3)(B) of this section within the first fifteen (15) months of service on the board of directors. 35 36 (2)(A) The superintendent of each school district shall annually

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1	prepare a report of the training hours each school board member received the		
2	previous calendar year and those carried forward from a previous year that		
3	were eligible to be counted towards the previous year to be presented to the		
4	board at the board's regular January meeting.		
5	(B) Members who fail to receive or carry forward the		
6	required number of training hours shall be:		
7	(i) Permitted thirty (30) days from the date of the		
8	January board meeting to complete the deficient training hours; and		
9	(ii) Suspended from participating in official		
10	business, except for school board training, until the board member obtains		
11	the deficient training hours.		
12	(C) A board member who fails to cure the board member's		
13	training hours deficiency within the thirty (30) days provided in subdivision		
14	(a)(2)(B) of this section shall be removed from the board and the board		
15	member's position shall be filled in accordance with § 6-13-611 unless:		
16	(i) The board member's failure to receive the		
17	required training was due to military service of the board member; or		
18	(ii) The board member provides a written sworn		
19	statement from the board member's treating physician stating that the board		
20	member's failure to receive the required training was due to a serious		
21	medical condition.		
22	(D) A board member who provides the necessary		
23	documentation under subdivision (a)(2)(C) of this section shall have until		
24	December 31 of the year following the year the board member failed to receive		
25	the required hours of training to receive both the hours of training under		
26	subdivision (a)(l) of this section for the current year and those the board		
27	member failed to obtain the previous year.		
28	(E) The board shall not appoint the board member who		
29	failed to receive the required hours of training to fill the vacant position		
30	on the board that resulted from the board member's failure to receive the		
31	required hours of training.		
32	(3)(A) The training and instruction required under this section		
33	shall include topics relevant to school laws, school operations, and the		
34	powers, duties, and responsibilities of the members of the board of		
35	directors, including without limitation:		
36	(i) Legal requirements, including without		

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limitation: (a) The items listed or required by the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee under § 6-1-101; and (b) Other financial laws or regulations designated by the Department of Education; (ii) Role differentiation; (iii) Financial management, including without limitation how to read and interpret an audit report; and (iv) Improving student achievement. /s/Sturch
