17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-126 is amended to read as follows:
20 5-14-126. Sexual assault in the third degree.

21 (a) A person commits sexual assault in the third degree if the person:

22 (1) Engages in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual activity
23 with another person who is not the actor's spouse, and the actor is:

24 (A) Employed with the Department of Correction, Department
25 of Community Correction, Department of Human Services, or any city or county
26 jail, ~~and~~ the victim is in the custody of the Department of Correction,
27 Department of Community Correction, Department of Human Services, or any city
28 or county jail, and the actor is in a position of trust or authority over the
29 victim and uses the position of trust or authority to engage in sexual
30 intercourse or deviate sexual activity;

31 (B) Employed or contracted with or otherwise providing
32 services, supplies, or supervision to an agency maintaining custody of
33 inmates, detainees, or juveniles, ~~and~~ the victim is in the custody of the
34 Department of Correction, Department of Community Correction, Department of
35 Human Services, or any city or county jail, and the actor is in a position of
36 trust or authority over the victim and uses the position of trust or



1 authority to engage in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual activity; or

2 (C) A mandated reporter under § 12-18-402(b) or a member
3 of the clergy and is in a position of trust or authority over the victim and
4 uses the position of trust or authority to engage in sexual intercourse or
5 deviate sexual activity; or

6 (2)(A) Being a minor, engages in sexual intercourse or deviate
7 sexual activity with another person who is:

8 (i) Less than fourteen (14) years of age; and

9 (ii) Not the person's spouse.

10 (B) It is an affirmative defense under this subdivision
11 (a)(2) that the actor was not more than three (3) years older than the
12 victim.

13 (b) It is no defense to a prosecution under this section that the
14 victim consented to the conduct.

15 (c) Sexual assault in the third degree is a Class C felony.
