26	SECTION 1. DO	NOT CODIFY. <u>Legislative findings</u> ,	intent, and purpose.
27	(a) The Genera	l Assembly finds that it is the poli	icy of the State of
28	Arkansas to support equal opportunity as well as economic development in		
29	every sector.		
30	(b) It is the	intent of the General Assembly to en	ncourage a more
31	diverse and inclusive opportunity for minority-owned businesses and female-		
32	owned business.		
33	(c) The purpose	e of this act is to support to the f	fullest all possible
34	participation of firms owned and controlled by minorities and females in the		
35	development of medica	l marijuana within the State of Arka	ansas.

- 1 SECTION 2. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98,
- 2 also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", Arkansas
- 3 Constitution, Amendment 98, § 8 is amended to add a new subdivision to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 (p) When issuing a license for a dispensary or cultivation facility,
- 6 the commission shall consider racial and gender diversity in ownership of an
- 7 applicant dispensary or cultivation facility.

- 9 SECTION 3. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98,
- 10 also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", Arkansas
- 11 Constitution, Amendment 98, § 19 is amended to read as follows:
- 12 § 19. Medical Marijuana Commission Creation.
- 13 (a)(1) There is created a Medical Marijuana Commission to determine
- 14 the qualifications for receiving a license to operate a dispensary or a
- 15 license to operate a cultivation facility and the awarding of licenses.
- 16 (2) Each member of the commission shall serve a term of four (4)
- 17 years.
- 18 (3) The commission shall consist of five (5) member as follows:
- 19 (A) Two (2) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore
- 20 of the Senate:
- 21 (B) Two (2) members appointed by the Speaker of the House
- 22 of Representatives; and
- 23 (C) One (1) member appointed by the Governor.
- 24 (4) Vacancies on the commission shall be filled in the manner of
- 25 the original appointment.
- 26 (5) The commission shall select one (1) of its members as chair.
- 27 (6) An affirmative vote of a majority of a quorum present shall
- 28 be necessary to transact business.
- 29 <u>(7) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the</u>
- 30 House of Representatives, and the Governor shall consider diversity when
- 31 appointing individuals to the commission.
- 32 (b)(1)(A) One (1) of the initial members appointed by the President
- 33 Pro Tempore of the Senate shall serve a term of two (2) years and one (1) of
- 34 the initial members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
- 35 shall serve a term of four (4) years.
- 36 (B) The initial members appointed by the President Pro

- 1 Tempore of the Senate shall draw lots to determine which member shall serve a
- 2 term of two (2) years.
- 3 (2)(A) One (1) of the initial members appointed by the Speaker
- 4 of the House of Representatives shall serve a term of two (2) years and one
- 5 (1) of the initial members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 6 Representatives shall serve a term of four (4) years.
- 7 (B) The initial members appointed by the Speaker of the
- 8 House of Representatives shall draw lots to determine which member shall
- 9 serve a term of two (2) years.
- 10 (3) The initial member appointed by the Governor shall serve a
- 11 term of four (4) years.
- 12 (4) All subsequent persons appointed to the commission shall
- 13 serve a term of four (4) years.
- 14 (c) A member of the commission shall be:
- 15 (1) <u>Be:</u>
- 16 (A) A citizen of the United States;
- 17 (2)(B) A resident of the State of Arkansas for at least ten (10)
- 18 years preceding his or her appointment;
- 19 (3)(C) A qualified elector; and
- 20 (4)(D) At least twenty-five (25) years of age; and
- 21 $\frac{(5)(2)}{(5)}$ Have no economic interest in a dispensary or cultivation
- 22 facility.
- 23 (d)(1) The commission, by a majority vote of the total membership of
- 24 the commission cast during its first regularly scheduled meeting of each
- 25 calendar year, may authorize payment to its members of a stipend not to
- 26 exceed eighty-five dollars (\$85.00) per day for each meeting attended or for
- 27 any day while performing any proper business of the commission.
- 28 (2) Members of the commission shall receive no other
- 29 compensation, expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of payments.
- 30 (e)(1) The commission may employ staff necessary to assist in the
- 31 performance of its duties under this amendment.
- 32 (2) The Alcoholic Beverage Control Division shall provide staff
- 33 for the commission if the commission does not have employees available for
- 34 that purpose.
- 35 (f)(1) Initial members of the commission shall be appointed within
- 36 thirty (30) days of the effective date of this section.

1	(2) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall call the first
2	meeting of the commission, which shall occur within forty-five (45) days of
3	the effective date of this section.
4	(g) The commission shall comply with all laws otherwise applicable to
5	other state commissions, including without limitation the Minority Business
6	Economic Development Act, § 15-4-301 et seq., and the Arkansas Procurement
7	Law, § 19-11-201 et seq.
