## Subtitle

14 TO PROVIDE FOR ARKANSAS AGRITOURISM SIGNS  
15 AT STATE WELCOME CENTERS AND TOURIST  
16 INFORMATION CENTERS THROUGH THE ARKANSAS  
17 WINE COUNTRY TRAILS PROGRAM.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-67-224, concerning the Arkansas Wine  
24 Country Trail, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

25 (c)(1) The Department of Parks and Tourism and the Arkansas State  
26 Highway and Transportation Department, in conjunction with the Arkansas Wine  
27 Producers Council, shall develop and install signs to promote Arkansas  
28 agritourism, incorporating Arkansas Wine Country Trail symbols, to be  
29 installed:

30 (A) On the main thoroughfare approaching welcome centers  
31 or tourist information centers within one (1) mile of the entrance to welcome  
32 centers or tourist information centers; or

33 (B) If installation on approach is not feasible, then on  
34 the main thoroughfare within one (1) mile past the entrance to welcome  
35 centers and tourist information centers or, if no feasible space exists in  
36 that mile, then as soon after that mile as possible.

(2) The signs shall be:

(A) A minimum of twelve feet by forty-eight feet (12' x 48'); and

(B) Constructed from:

(i) Steel; or

(ii) Treated lumber and recycled utility poles.
