19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-1306 is amended to read as follows	:
22	27-24-1306. Emergency medical technicians services professionals.	
23	(a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall create and	
24	issue a special license plate for emergency medical technicians services	
25	professionals.	
26	(b) The <del>Department of Finance and Administration</del> <u>department</u> shall	
27	design the special license plates issued under this section.	
28	(c) Any one (l) of the following may apply for and annually renew a	
29	special license plate issued under this section if he or she is currently	
30	certified <u>licensed</u> in the State of Arkansas <u>or certified with the National</u>	
31	Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians and resides in this state as:	
32	(1) An emergency medical technician;	
33	(2) An A emergency medical technician paramedic;	
34	(3) An <u>advanced</u> emergency medical technician <del>intermediate</del> ; or	
35	(4) A first responder with the documented completion of forty	
36	(40) hours of curriculum approved by the Department of Transportation	

1	National Highway Traffic Safety Administration; or
2	(5) Any other Emergency Medical Services Personnel, including
3	without limitation:
4	(A) A dispatcher; or
5	(B) An emergency vehicle operator.
6	(d) An applicant shall remit the following fees to obtain a special
7	license plate issued under this section for use on a motor vehicle:
8	(1) The fee required by law for the registration and licensing
9	of the motor vehicle;
10	(2) A handling and administrative fee in the amount of ten
11	dollars (\$10.00); and
12	(3) An additional fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) to be
13	collected by the <del>Department of Finance and Administration</del> <u>department</u> and
14	remitted monthly to the Arkansas EMT Association Benevolence and Scholarship
15	Funds Emergency Medical Services Foundation, Inc.
16	(e)(1) The fee for the renewal of a special license plate under this
17	section is the fee required under subsection (d) of this section.
18	(2) The replacement fee for a special license plate issued under
19	this section is ten dollars (\$10.00).
20	(f) Upon the initial application of a special license plate issued
21	under this section, the emergency medical <del>technician</del> <u>services professional</u>
22	shall provide adequate proof to the <del>Department of Finance and Administration</del>
23	<u>department</u> that he or she is <del>certified</del> <u>licensed</u> in the State of Arkansas <u>or</u>
24	certified with the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians and
25	resides in this state as one (1) of the following:
26	(1) An emergency medical technician;
27	(2) An A emergency medical technician paramedic;
28	(3) An <u>advanced</u> emergency medical technician <del>intermediate</del> ; <del>or</del>
29	(4) A first responder with the documented completion of forty
30	(40) hours of curriculum approved by the <del>Department of Transportation</del>
31	National Highway Traffic Safety Administration; or
32	(5) Any other Emergency Medical Services Personnel, including

36	(g)(1) The fee remitted under subdivision $(d)(2)(B)$ of this section

1	shall be deposited into the State Central Services Fund for the benefit of
2	the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.
3	(2) The fee shall be credited as supplemental and in addition to
4	all other funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the division.
5	(3) The fee shall not be considered or credited to the division
6	as direct revenue.
7	(h) The registration of a special license plate under this section
8	may:
9	(1) Continue from year to year as long as it is renewed each
10	year within the time and manner required by law; and
11	(2) Be renewed as provided under §§ 27-14-1012 and 27-14-1013.
