27	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code § 27-14-414 is amende	d to read as follows:
28	27-14-414. Vehicle	Insurance Database.	
29	(a) There is created	the Vehicle Insurance Data	<del>base within the Revenue</del>
30	Division of the Department	of Finance and Administrat	<del>ion to develop,</del>
31	establish, and maintain a	database of information to	verify compliance with
32	the motor vehicle liabilit	y insurance laws of Arkansa	s set out in § 27-22-101
33	et seq.		
34	(b)(1) The Vehicle I	nsurance Database shall be	administered by the
35	division with the assistan	ace of the Department of Inf	ormation Systems or any
36	other designated agent whi	ch may be contracted with t	<del>o supply technical</del>

1	database and data processing expertise.
2	(2) The Vehicle Insurance Database shall be developed and
3	maintained in accordance with guidelines established by the division so that
4	the state and local law enforcement agencies can access the Vehicle Insurance
5	Database to check the current insurance coverage on motor vehicles in
6	Arkansas required to maintain current liability insurance as required by law
7	(c) The division shall have the authority to enter into or to make
8	agreements, arrangements, or declarations necessary to carry out the
9	provisions of this section.
10	(d) The reports shall be retained by the Department of Finance and
11	Administration so as to keep a twelve-month history of the insurance record
12	of the vehicle for at least the preceding full twelve-month period.
13	(e)(1) Upon request, the Department of Finance and Administration may
14	release an individual's information in the Vehicle Insurance Database to:
15	(A) That individual;
16	(B) The parent or legal guardian of that individual who is
17	under eighteen (18) years of age or who is legally incapacitated; and
18	(C) State and local law enforcement agencies, to the
19	Arkansas Crime Information Center, or to other government offices upon a
20	showing of need.
21	(2) Otherwise, all data and information received by the Vehicle
22	Insurance Database are confidential and are not subject to examination or
23	disclosure as public information under the Freedom of Information Act of
24	<del>1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.</del>
25	(f) The department or the reporting company shall not be liable for any
26	damages to any property or person due to any act or omission in the reporting
27	of or keeping of any record or information under the Vehicle Insurance
28	Database or the issuing or renewing of any motor vehicle registration in
29	accordance with the Vehicle Insurance Database.
30	(g) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
31	have the authority to adopt rules and regulations necessary to carry out the
32	provisions of this section.
33	(a)(1) The Department of Finance and Administration, in cooperation
34	with the Insurance Commissioner and the Department of Arkansas State Police,
35	shall establish an accessible online motor vehicle liability insurance
36	verification system to be known as the "Vehicle Insurance Database"

1	(2) The purpose of the database is to verify the compliance of a
2	motor vehicle owner or operator with the minimum motor vehicle liability
3	insurance requirements under § 27-22-104.
4	(3) The database shall be designed to:
5	(A) Reduce the number of uninsured motorists in this
6	state;
7	(B) Operate reliably;
8	(C) Be cost-effective;
9	(D) Protect sufficiently the privacy of the motor vehicle
10	owner or operator;
11	(E) Safeguard sufficiently the security and integrity of
12	information provided by motor vehicle liability insurance companies;
13	(F) Identify and employ a method of compliance that
14	improves public convenience; and
15	(G) Provide information that is:
16	(i) Accurate and current; and
17	(ii) Capable of being audited by an independent
18	auditor.
19	(4) The Department of Finance and Administration:
20	(A)(i) May contract with a private vendor or vendors to
21	develop, implement, operate, and maintain all or part of the database.
22	(ii) A vendor shall be selected under the Arkansas
23	Procurement Law, § 19-11-201 et seq.; and
24	(B) Is not subject to liability or suit for any error in
25	the database.
26	(b) The database shall:
27	(1) Contain information provided in § 27-22-107 by motor vehicle
28	liability insurers to verify motor vehicle liability insurance coverage using
29	electronic services established by the Department of Finance and
30	Administration;
31	(2) Include appropriate provisions to secure the database's data
32	against unauthorized access and to maintain a record of all requests and
33	responses;
34	(3) Be accessible without fee to:
35	(A) Authorized personnel and authorized agents of the
36	Department of Finance and Administration:

1	(B) The Insurance Commissioner;
2	(C) The courts;
3	(D) Law enforcement personnel; and
4	(E) County assessors;
5	(4) Interface, when possible, with existing computer systems and
6	applications of the Department of Finance and Administration and law
7	enforcement agencies;
8	(5) Receive motor vehicle liability insurance data file
9	transfers from motor vehicle liability insurers under specifications and
10	standards established by the Department of Finance and Administration to
11	identify vehicles that are not covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance
12	<pre>policy;</pre>
13	(6) Provide a means by which low-volume motor vehicle liability
14	insurers that are unable to deploy an online interface with the database can
15	report motor vehicle liability insurance policy data to the Department of
16	Finance and Administration or its designee for inclusion in the database;
17	(7) Provide a means to track separately and verify the existence
18	or nonexistence of minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage for or
19	distinguish motor vehicles that are:
20	(A) Subject to a certificate of self-insurance under § 27-
21	<u>19-107;</u>
22	(B) Reported under subdivision (b)(6) of this section; or
23	(C) Registered but not subject to a motor vehicle
24	liability insurance verification by any other means provided by this section;
25	(8) Be available at all times, subject to reasonable allowances
26	for scheduled maintenance or temporary system failures, to verify the motor
27	vehicle liability insurance status of any vehicle in a manner prescribed by
28	the Department of Finance and Administration;
29	(9) Provide a means to facilitate the administration and notice
30	of suspension of motor vehicle registration under § 27-22-103 upon receipt of
31	notice that a motor vehicle liability insurance policy has been cancelled or
32	no longer meets the minimum coverage requirements of § 27-22-104;
33	(10) Receive motor vehicle registration data file transfers each
34	month from the Department of Finance and Administration to identify vehicles
35	that are currently registered in this state; and
36	(11)(A) Be prima facie evidence of the existence or nonexistence

1	of minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage.
2	(B) The presumption under subdivision (b)(11)(A) of this
3	section is rebuttable by a proof-of-insurance card issued under § 23-89-213
4	within the preceding sixty (60) days of the attempt to verify motor vehicle
5	liability insurance coverage.
6	(c)(1) Information obtained under this section and § 27-22-107:
7	(A) Is confidential;
8	(B) May be used only by authorized personnel and
9	authorized agents of the Department of Finance and Administration, the
10	Insurance Commissioner, the courts, law enforcement personnel, and county
11	assessors for a purpose authorized under this section and § 27-22-101 et
12	seq.; and
13	(C) Pertaining to an individual, may be released only to
14	the following individuals or entities at the request of the individual or
15	entity:
16	(i) The individual;
17	(ii) The parent or legal guardian of the individual
18	if the individual is under eighteen (18) years of age or is legally
19	incapacitated; and
20	(iii) State and local law enforcement agencies, the
21	Arkansas Crime Information Center, or other government offices upon a showing
22	of need.
23	(2) The Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.,
24	does not apply to the information contained in the database.
25	(d) A motor vehicle liability insurer:
26	(1) Shall cooperate with the Department of Finance and
27	Administration to establish and maintain the database and the integrity of
28	the database;
29	(2) Shall provide access to the status of motor vehicle
30	liability insurance policy information to verify motor vehicle liability
31	insurance coverage:
32	(A) For a vehicle insured by the motor vehicle liability
33	insurer that is registered in this state; and
34	(B) If available, for a vehicle that is insured by the
35	motor vehicle liability insurer or that is operated in this state and the
36	subject of an accident investigation, regardless of where the vehicle is

I	registered; and
2	(3) Is not liable for an act or omission taken in good faith to
3	comply with this section or § 27-22-107.
4	(e) This section does not apply to motor vehicle insurance that is
5	written under a commercial motor vehicle liability coverage form approved by
6	the Insurance Commissioner.
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8	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-22-104(a)(2)(A), concerning the failure
9	to present proof of insurance at the time of a traffic stop, is amended to
10	read as follows:
11	(2)(A)(i) Failure to present proof of insurance coverage at the
12	time of a traffic stop, or arrest or proof of a failure of the Vehicle
13	Insurance Database, or $\frac{1}{1}$ or $\frac{1}{1$
14	under § 23-89-213 within the preceding sixty (60) days to show current the
15	minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage at the time of the traffic
16	stop required by this section creates a rebuttable presumption that:
17	(a) the The motor vehicle or the person's
18	operation of the motor vehicle is <del>uninsured</del> <u>not in compliance with the</u>
19	minimum motor vehicle liability insurance coverage requirements of this
20	section; and
21	(b) The operator of the motor vehicle failed
22	to present the proof-of-insurance card required by § 27-22-111(a).
23	(ii) The law enforcement officer who conducts the
24	stop shall search the name of the operator and the vehicle identification
25	number of the stopped motor vehicle to determine compliance with this
26	section.

28	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-22-107 is amended to read as follows:
29	27-22-107. Motor vehicle insurance reporting.
30	(a) $\frac{(1)}{(1)}$ Each An insurance company providing that provides motor vehicle
31	liability insurance coverage <del>required under § 27-22-104(a),</del> in this state
32	shall provide <del>before the seventh day of each calendar month to the Revenue</del>
33	$\frac{\text{Division}}{\text{Division}}$ all information in the time and manner required by $\frac{1}{2}$ the Department
34	of Finance and Administration $a$ record of each motor vehicle insurance policy
35	in effect as of the previous month that was issued by the insurance company.
36	The reports shall be provided to the division through any means of electronic

1	or electromagnetic medium available to and approved by the department, unless
2	the insurance company qualifies for an exception to this electronics
3	reporting requirement as a result of being a small or low-volume insurer as
4	may otherwise be provided for under regulations promulgated by the Department
5	of Finance and Administration.
6	(2)(A) The Director of the Department of Finance and
7	Administration may choose a vendor to provide an online insurance
8	verification system which will comply with the industry standards as
9	recommended by the Insurance Industry Committee on Motor Vehicle
10	Administration when there are two (2) or more vendors that demonstrate to the
11	department the ability to meet the Industry Committee on Motor Vehicle
12	Administration standard.
13	(i) The department shall notify each insurance
14	company in writing of the chosen vendor. If the insurance company elects to
15	participate in the online insurance verification system that complies with
16	the industry standards, the company may then work with the vendor and the
17	department on an agreeable schedule to convert to the new system.
18	(ii) If an insurance company elects to participate
19	in the online insurance verification system, then the insurance company will
20	be exempt from providing the report before the seventh day of each calendar
21	month as the department and law enforcement will be able to obtain data
22	online in real time.
23	(B) If the director certifies that seventy percent (70%)
24	or more of the motor vehicle insurance policies in effect on a specific date
25	are being accessed according to the industry standards in the online
26	insurance verification system, each insurance company shall provide access to
27	the data through the online insurance verification system.
28	(C) At the discretion of the department, rules and
29	regulations may be established to offer insurers who write fewer policies an
30	alternative method for reporting insurance policy data.
31	(D) The department shall select a vendor under the
32	Arkansas Procurement Law, § 19-11-201 et seq.
33	(b)(1) The reports submission by each insurance company shall include
34	for each motor vehicle liability insurance policy:
35	$\frac{(A)(1)}{(1)}$ The name and the address of the each named insured;
36	$\frac{(B)(2)}{(B)}$ The make, year, and vehicle identification number

1 of each insured vehicle; and 2 (C)(3) The name of the insurance provider, policy number, 3 effective date, and expiration date of each motor vehicle liability insurance 4 policy,; 5 (D)(4) The NAIC number assigned by the National 6 Association of Insurance Carriers code number Commissioners to the insurance 7 company,; and 8 (5) the The name of each driver excluded from coverage.; 9 (2) The reports may include: 10  $\frac{(A)}{(b)}$  The date of birth of each insured owner or 11 operator; and 12 (B)(7) The driver's license number of each insured owner 13 or operator. 14 (c)(1) The department may shall, by following procedures set forth in 15 regulations rules promulgated by the department, assess a penalty against 16 each an insurance company of up to not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars 17 (\$250) for each day the insurance company fails to comply with this section. 18 (2) If an insurance company shows that the failure to comply 19 with this section was inadvertent, accidental, outside of the control of the 20 insurance company, or the result of excusable neglect, the Director of the 21 Department of Finance and Administration may excuse the penalty. 22 (3) The moneys collected from these the penalties prescribed by 23 this subsection shall be deposited as a special revenue into the State 24 Central Services Fund, and the net amount shall be credited as a direct 25 revenue to be used by the department to offset the costs of administering 26 this section. 27 (d) The department shall promulgate necessary rules and regulations 28 for the administration of this section. 15	(a) If it is determined from the information obtained from the Vehicle
16	Insurance Database or an insurance company under § 27-22-107 that a motor
17	vehicle is not covered by the minimum liability insurance required under this
18	subchapter, the Department of Finance and Administration or a private vendor
19	or vendors authorized under § 27-14-414(a)(4) shall send the registered owner
20	of the motor vehicle a letter giving notice of noncompliance.
21	(b) A registered owner of a motor vehicle who receives a notice of
22	noncompliance based on inaccurate information obtained from the database or
23	an insurance company under § 27-22-107 shall provide proof of coverage to the
24	department within fifteen (15) days from the mailing date of the notice of
25	noncompliance under subsection (a) of this section.
26	(c) The department may promulgate rules to implement and administer
27	this subchapter.
