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3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-1-602(8), concerning definitions
4	pertaining to the Arkansas Whistle-Blower Act, is amended to read as follows:
5	(8) "Whistle-blower" means a person who witnesses or has
6	evidence of a waste or violation while employed with a public employer and
7	who communicates in good faith or testifies to the waste or violation,
8	verbally or in writing, to one of the employee's superiors, to an agent of
9	the public employer, or to an the appropriate authority, provided that the
10	communication is made prior to before any adverse action by the employer.
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12	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 21-1-610(b), concerning the reward to a
13	state employee when communication of waste or violation results in savings of
14	state funds, is amended to read as follows:
15	(b) A state employee making a communication under § 21-1-603 shall be
16	eligible to receive a reward in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) twenty
17	percent (20%) of any savings in state funds attributable to changes made
18	based on a communication under § 21-1-603.

20	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 21-1-610(d)(2)(A)(iii), concerning the
21	reward to a state employee when communication of waste or violation results
22	in savings of state funds, is amended to read as follows:
23	(iii) The amount of the reward for which the state
24	employee is eligible. The amount of the reward shall be equal to ten percent
25	(10%) twenty percent $(20%)$ of the total savings in state funds reported under
26	subdivision $(d)(2)(A)(i)$ of this section. If the state employer concludes
27	that the state employee is not eligible for a reward, the state employer
28	shall state the reasons for that determination in the report.
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
