10	shall slow down as necessary for safety but may proceed cautiously past the	
11	red or stop sign or signal.

13	shall stop in obedience to a stop sign or signal.

30	responding to emergency calls when the driver thereof of the emergency	
31	<u>vehicle</u> is operating the vehicle's emergency lights and is also operating an	
32	audible signal by bell, siren, or exhaust whistle if other vehicles are	
33	present.	
34	(2) The driver of an authorized emergency vehicle operated as a	
35	police vehicle is not required to operate a siren or flashing lights when	
36	operating the emergency vehicle as authorized under § 27-51-905.	

1	(b) This section shall does not relieve the driver of an authorized
2	emergency vehicle from the duty to drive with due regard for the safety of
3	all persons using the street, nor shall it protect the driver of any
4	emergency vehicle from the consequence of a reckless disregard of the safety
5	of others.
6	(c) For purposes of this section, "emergency calls" means legitimate
7	emergency situations which call for the operation of an emergency vehicle,
8	including a police vehicle.
9 10	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 51, Subchapter 9, is
11	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
12	27-51-905. Police vehicle exceptions.
13	(a) An authorized emergency vehicle operated as a police vehicle is
14	not required to operate the vehicle's siren or flashing lights when the
15	emergency vehicle is responding to an emergency call or when in pursuit of an
16	actual or suspected violator if the emergency vehicle is being used to:
17	(1) Obtain evidence of a speeding violation;
18	(2) Respond to a suspected crime in progress when use of an
19	audible or visual signal could result in the destruction of evidence or
20	escape of a suspect; or
21	(3) Conduct surveillance of a vehicle or the passengers of a
22	vehicle who are suspected of involvement in a crime.
23	(b) This section does not relieve the driver of an authorized
24	emergency vehicle operated as a police vehicle from:
25	(1) The duty to drive with regard for the safety of all persons
26	using the street; or
27	(2) Any legal consequence resulting of a reckless disregard of
28	the safety of others.
