- (d) The Director of the Arkansas Natural Heritage Commission may apply to the circuit court of any county in which a violation of this subchapter is occurring or in which the director has reasonable cause to believe a violation of this subchapter is about to occur, and that the circuit court shall have jurisdiction to grant a temporary or permanent injunction restraining any person from violating this subchapter without requiring the director to post bond during the pendency of this the action described in this subsection.
- (e)(1) In addition to criminal penalties set forth in under subsection (b) of this section, any a person who violates any rules and regulations a rule promulgated by the commission governing a natural areas area or who causes such a violation by his or her employee or agent shall be is liable for a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500) or three (3) times the value of the damages caused, whichever is the greater, and the penalty to shall be recovered in an action brought by the Attorney General or the commission's attorney in the proper circuit court.
- (2) The <u>civil</u> penalty <u>described in subdivision (e)(1) of this</u> <u>section</u> shall be used to restore the natural area or to secure the preservation of similar areas.
