21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is*
24 *amended to add an additional section to read as follows:*

25 *12-12-110. Body cameras.*

26 *(a) As used in this section, "body-worn camera" means an electronic*
27 *device worn on a person's body that records both audio and video. (b)(1) A*
28 *state or local law enforcement agency shall implement the use of body-worn*
29 *cameras under guidelines to be established by the Commission on Law*
30 *Enforcement Standards and Training.*

31 *(2) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement the*
32 *provisions of this section.*
