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1	(3) Providing tax credits to taxpayers for contributions in aid
2	of construction of capital improvements for public roads projects will
3	encourage public and private participation in these capital improvement
4	projects, will promote the economic welfare of this state and its people, and
5	is in the public interest.

7	15-4-2303. Definitions.
8	As used in this subchapter:
9	(1) "Capital improvements" means capital improvements for public
10	roads;
11	(2) "Commission" means the Arkansas Economic Development
12	Commission;
13	(3) "Contribution" means a contribution in aid of construction
14	of a public roads project made by a taxpayer to the Public Roads Incentive
15	Fund;
16	(4) "Gouncil" means the Arkansas Economic Development Council;
17	(5) "Gounty" means any county in the State of Arkansas;
18	(6) "Executive director" means the Executive Director of the
19	Arkansas Economic Development Commission;
20	(7) "Fund" means the Public Roads Incentive Fund;
21	(8) "Governing authority" means the quorum court of a county,
22	the governing body of a municipality, and the State Highway Commission;
23	(9) "Municipality" means any city or incorporated town in the
24	State of Arkansas;
25	(10) "Project" means all, any combination, or any part of the
26	capital improvements for public roads which are authorized by a governing
27	authority and approved by the executive director;
28	(11) "Public roads" means roads maintained by a governing
29	authority; and
30	(12) "Taxpayer" includes any individual, fiduciary, or
31	corporation subject to Arkansas state income tax.
32	
33	15-4-2304. Approval of projects.
34	Governing authorities may apply to the Executive Director of the
35	Arkansas Economic Development Commission for funding assistance for capital
0.6	improvement projects for public reads as provided by this subshapes. The

1	executive director is authorized to approve capital improvements for funding
2	assistance upon a finding that a project is in the public interest.
3	
4	15-4-2305. Public Roads Incentive Fund.
5	(a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
6	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be
7	known as the "Public Roads Incentive Fund" of the Arkansas Economic
8	Development Council.
9	(b) The fund shall consist of contributions made by taxpayers for
10	public roads projects approved by the Executive Director of the Arkansas
11	Economic Development Commission and any other funds as are designated or
12	deposited to the fund by law.
13	(c)(l) A separate account shall be established for each project, and
14	contributions for a project shall be applied to provide funding assistance
15	for such a project.
16	(2) Any contributions which remain in the fund when a project is
17	completed or terminated shall be held and applied to other public roads
18	projects in such manner as the executive director shall direct.
19	
20	15-4-2306. Tax credit.
21	(a) A taxpayer shall be entitled to a credit against any Arkansas
22	income tax liability which may be imposed on the taxpayer for any tax year
23	commencing on or after January 1, 1999, for contributions transmitted to the
24	Treasurer of State pursuant to this subchapter.
25	(b) The credit shall be determined in the following manner:
26	(1) The credit is limited to an amount not to exceed thirty-
27	three percent (33%) of the taxpayer's contribution;
28	(2) In any one (1) tax year, the credit allowed by this section
29	shall not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the net Arkansas state income tax
30	liability of the taxpayer after all other credits and reductions in tax have
31	been calculated; and
32	(3) Any credit in excess of the amount allowed by subdivision
33	(b)(2) of this section for any one (1) tax year may be carried forward and
34	applied against any Arkansas state income tax liability for the next-
35	succeeding tax year and annually thereafter for a total period of three (3)
36	years next succeeding the year in which the credit arose, subject to the

1	provisions of supervision (b)(z) of this section or until the credit is
2	exhausted, whichever occurs first.
3	
4	15-4-2307. Powers and duties of the Arkansas Economic Development
5	Commission.
6	The Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall administer the
7	provisions of this subchapter and shall have the following powers and duties
8	in addition to those mentioned in this subchapter and in other laws of this
9	state:
10	(1) To monitor the implementation and operation of this
11	subchapter and to conduct a continuing evaluation of the progress made;
12	(2) To assist the governing authority in obtaining assistance
13	from any other department of state government;
14	(3) To submit an annual written report evaluating the
15	effectiveness of the program and presenting any suggestions for improving the
16	program, to be submitted to the Governor no later than March 1 of each year;
17	and
18	(4) To promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the
19	Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq., necessary to
20	carry out the provisions of this subchapter.
