16	WHEREAS, Christopher A. Masingill was appointed by President Obama and
17	confirmed by the United States Senate in 2010 to serve as the Federal Co-
18	Chairman of the Delta Regional Authority; and in his six (6) years with the
19	Delta Regional Authority, Chairman Masingill has made it his hallmark to
20	develop strategic connections between the public and private sectors to
21	achieve economic and community development results on the local, state, and
22	national levels; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, before leading the Delta Regional Authority, Chairman
25	Masingill served the state as Governor Mike Beebe's Director of
26	Intergovernmental Affairs, and during that time was the Arkansas Recovery
27	Implementation Director for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
28	2009, coordinating the implementation of \$3 billion (\$3,000,000,000) of
29	investment into forty-eight (48) programs across thirteen (13) state
30	agencies; and

32	WHEREAS, Chairman Masingill believes in the natural, economic, and
33	human assets of Delta communities and the opportunities those assets create
34	for the region; he has placed a strong emphasis on supporting small
35	businesses and entrepreneurs as well as investing in workforce development
36	and training efforts, recognizing these efforts as the greatest opportunities

- 1 for the Delta region's economy; he has worked with the governors of the eight
- 2 (8) Delta states to leverage \$44 million (\$44,000,000) in authority
- 3 investments into nearly \$1 billion (\$1,000,000,000) in private and other
- 4 public sector investment in Delta communities; and authority investments are
- 5 helping to create and retain forty-two thousand (42,000) jobs and train
- 6 thirteen thousand (13,000) workers; and

- 8 WHEREAS, to further the investments under Chairman Masingill's
- 9 leadership, the authority launched the Small Business & Entrepreneurship
- 10 Initiative to focus investments into organizations and programs that support
- 11 the cultivation of innovation and job creation that come from our small
- 12 businesses and entrepreneurs; and in 2014, the authority launched the
- 13 Reimagining the Delta Workforce initiative which organized eight (8) state
- 14 summits and invested \$1.7 million (\$1,700,000) into communities to address
- 15 the challenges of preparing a skilled workforce in Delta communities and to
- 16 connect local leadership in government, education, and business for
- 17 realistic, productive solutions; and
