34		and materials, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

8	SECTION 3. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. Applicability.		
9	A candidate running for reelection to the same office he or she		
10	currently holds who possesses or creates a campaign sign, campaign		
11	literature, or other printed campaign material that does not comply with this		
12	act is exempt from compliance with this act if the campaign sign, campaign		
13	literature, or other printed campaign material was created before the		
14	effective date of this act.
