4	Before allowing an initial exposure at a tanning facility of a person
5	under eighteen (18) years of age, the owner or operator shall witness the
6	person's parent or legal guardian signing and dating a warning statement as
7	follows:
8	"WARNING STATEMENT
9	This statement must be read and signed by a parent or legal guardian of any
10	person under eighteen (18) years of age before allowing the initial exposure
11	at this tanning facility.
12	DANCER - ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION WARNING
13	Follow instructions.
14	Avoid overexposure. As with natural sunlight, overexposure can cause eye and
15	skin injury and allergic reactions. Repeated exposure may cause premature
16	aging of the skin and skin cancer.
17	Wear protective eyewear. FAILURE TO USE PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR MAY RESULT IN
18	SEVERE BURNS OR LONG-TERM INJURY TO THE EYES.
19	Medications or cosmetics may increase your sensitivity to the ultraviolet
20	radiation. Consult a physician before using sunlamp or tanning equipment if
21	you are using medications or have a history of skin problems or believe
22	yourself to be especially sensitive to sunlight.

23	(a) A person commits the offense of permitting the use of tanning	
24	equipment at a tanning facility by a minor if the person knowingly permits a	
25	minor to use tanning equipment at a tanning facility.	
26	(b) Permitting the use of tanning equipment at a tanning facility by a	
27	minor is a Class A misdemeanor.	
28	(c)(l) An owner, lessee, or operator of a tanning facility shall post	
29	a notice in a conspicuous location in all tanning facilities owned, leased,	
30	or operated in this state.	
31	(2) The notice in subdivision (c)(1) shall be developed by the	
32	Department of Health and shall include the following statements:	
33	(A) "Allowing a person under eighteen (18) years of age to	
34	use tanning equipment is unlawful under Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 27,	
35	Subchapter 22"; and	
36	(B) "A tanning facility or operator that violates this

1	section is subject to a criminal penalty."
2	(d) This section does not apply to:
3	(1) The use of tanning equipment exclusively for personal and
4	noncommercial use; or
5	(2) A physician who is licensed to practice medicine in this
6	state and who uses or prescribes phototherapy devices or equipment to a
7	patient of any age.
