8 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE FOR RECESS OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
10 ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 7, 2017;
11 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF
12 THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON,
13 MAY 5, 2017, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,
14 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING ITS WORK
15 ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, AND
16 CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE
17 REGULAR SESSION OR TO ADJOURN THE NINETY-FIRST
18 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY
19 DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO RECONVENE; AND TO
20 PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT
21 RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY 5,
22 2017, THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
23 ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON THAT DATE.

27 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE
28 REGULAR SESSION OF THE NINETY-FIRST
29 GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND TO PROVIDE FOR A
30 RECESS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

33 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
34 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

36 (a) That the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly of



1 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 5, 2017;

2 (b) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, prior to
3 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days
4 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill, therefore from April
5 7, 2017, to May 5, 2017, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall be
6 open so the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and the
7 office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, vetoes of
8 bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;

9 (c) That the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly of
10 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess simultaneously at the close of
11 business in each chamber on April 7, 2017, or at such earlier time as may be
12 agreed upon by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

13 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President
14 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

15 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00
16 noon, May 5, 2017, for the purpose of:

17 (A) Considering vetoes;

18 (B) Correcting errors and oversights;

19 (C) Completing its work on proposed constitutional
20 amendments; and

21 (D) Considering the need for further extension of the
22 Regular Session of the Ninety-First General Assembly; or

23 (2) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General
24 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 5, 2017, if they determine it is
25 not necessary to reconvene; and

26 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before
27 12:00 noon, May 5, 2017, the Regular Session of the Ninety-First General
28 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
