20 WHEREAS, Miss Shields received a scholarship for fifty thousand dollars
21 (\$50,000) that she will use to complete her education at the University of
22 Arkansas at Fayetteville where she is a senior majoring in Art with a minor
23 in Business; and

25 WHEREAS, Miss Shields will travel the country on a year of service to
26 promote her personal platform, "Eat Better, Live Better," which aims to
27 educate people on how the foods we eat make an impact on our lives as a
28 whole; and

30 WHEREAS, during her time as Miss America, Miss Shields will also serve
31 as the National Goodwill Ambassador for Children's Miracle Network Hospitals;
32 and she hopes to use her time to advocate for change in the mindset of people
33 across our nation by encouraging them to embrace a lifestyle that can
34 drastically improve their health; and

36 WHEREAS, Miss Shields has already traveled over 100,000 miles as Miss
