17	collectively, <del>nor</del> <u>and</u> the Executive <del>Secretary</del> <u>Director</u> of the Arkansas State		
18	Medical Board, when acting on behalf of the board, shall be held are not		
19	liable for civil damages from claims pertaining to the administration of the

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22	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-99-305(a), concerning temporary permits		
23	of respiratory care practitioners, is amended to read as follows:		
24	(a) In cases of emergency, the Executive Secretary Director of the		
25	Arkansas State Medical Board may issue a temporary permit without examination		
26	to practice respiratory care to persons who are not licensed in other states,		
27	but who otherwise meet the qualifications for licensure set out in this		
28	chapter.		
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
