4	(2) Provide the compact administrator or the compact		
5	administrator's designee with information about the juvenile, to include		
6	without limitation the juvenile's:		
7	(A) Name;		
8	(B) Delinquency status or history;		
9	(C) Home address in the state of origin; and		
10	(D) Willingness to return home without further proceedings		
11	as provided in the compact.		
12	(b)(1) When a law enforcement agency or Division of Children and		
13	Family Services has physical custody of a runaway juvenile under subsection		
14	(a) of this section, the compact administrator or the compact administrator's		
15	designee shall assist the law enforcement agency or Division of Children and		
16	Family Services in finding appropriate placement for the juvenile while the		
17	juvenile's return to his or her home state is processed.		
18	(2) The cost of finding an appropriate placement for a juvenile		
19	runaway under subdivision (b)(l) of this section, including intrastate		
20	transportation costs that are not covered by the juvenile's legal custodian		
21	or home state, shall be the responsibility of the following agencies:		
22	(A) For a juvenile charged with a delinquent or criminal		
23	offense, the county in which the charge is pending; and		
24	(B) For a juvenile who is not charged with a delinquent or		
25	criminal offense, the Division of Youth Services.		
26	(3) The Division of Youth Services may pay interstate		
27	transportation costs for a juvenile runaway if those costs are not covered by		
28	the juvenile's legal custodian.		
29	(c) The Division of Children and Family Services is not responsible		
30	for the placement or transportation of a juvenile runaway under this section.
