22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
23		
24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-29-311(f), concerning prohibited condu	ct
25	of embalmers and funeral directors, is amended to read as follows:	
26	(f) (1) A dead human body that is not buried or otherwise disposed of	
27	within an allotted time $\frac{1}{1}$ to $\frac{1}{1}$ determined by rule of the board shall be	
28	embalmed as prescribed in this subchapter or $\ 17-29-201$ et seq. or stored	
29	under refrigeration as determined by the Department of Health $\underline{\mathtt{or}}$ its	
30	successor or successors concerning the preservation of bodies.	
31	(2)(A) When taking custody of the dead human body as prescribe	<u>d</u>
32	in this subchapter or § 17-29-201 et seq. or when the dead human body is	
33	stored under refrigeration as determined by the department, a funeral	
34	establishment or crematory shall maintain the dead human body in a manner	
35	that provides for complete coverage of the dead human body and prevents	
36	leakage or spillage by properly storing the dead human body in a	

1	refrigeration or preparation room at all times except during:
2	(i) Identification, embalming, or preparation of an
3	unembalmed dead human body for final disposition;
4	(ii) Restoration and dressing of a dead human body
5	in preparation for final disposition; or
6	(iii) Viewing during a visitation or funeral
7	service.
8	(B) The funeral establishment or crematory shall treat the
9	dead human body with dignity and respect as determined by rule of the board.
10	(3)(A) If a funeral establishment or crematory is unable to
11	secure or store a dead human body as required under subdivision (f)(1) of
12	this section due to an unforeseen circumstance, the funeral establishment or
13	crematory shall transfer the dead human body and notify the board and the
14	person or entity having the legal right to arrange for the final disposition
15	of the dead human body.
16	(B) The notice required under subdivision (f)(3)(A) of
17	this section shall:
18	(i) Be provided within twenty-four (24) hours after
19	the occurrence of the unforeseen circumstance; and
20	(ii) Include the:
21	(a) Name and location of the facility where a
22	dead human body is being transferred;
23	(b) Reason for the transfer; and
24	(c) Method of storage.
25	(4) A dead human body shall not be embalmed or artificially
26	<pre>preserved without:</pre>
27	(A) The express permission of a person or entity with the
28	legal right to arrange for the final disposition of the dead human body under
29	the Arkansas Final Disposition Rights Act of 2009, § 20-17-102; or
30	(B) A court order.
31	(5) A funeral establishment or crematory shall not store a dead
32	human body until final disposition at a funeral establishment or crematory
33	without a license under this subchapter or § 17-29-201 et seq.
34	(6) A funeral establishment, crematory, or a transport service
35	of human remains licensed under this subchapter shall not transport or store
36	a dead human body together with animal remains in the same confined space.
