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           SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-85-210(a), concerning continuing
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     eligibility, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
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                 (4) A recipient may attend summer terms at the student's own
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     expense to earn credit hours necessary to maintain eligibility for a
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     scholarship under this subchapter.
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           SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-85-210(c), concerning continuing
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     eligibility, is amended to read as follows:
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           (c)(l)<del>(A) If a recipient becomes incligible for the scholarship</del>
     because the recipient's postsecondary grade point average or number of
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     successfully completed credit hours no longer meets the minimum requirement
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     for the scholarship, the recipient may regain eligibility under this
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     subsection one (1) time only in the academic year in which the student became
