BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
THAT Representative Ballinger is authorized to introduce a bill which as
introduced will read substantially as follows:
"For An Act To Be Entitled
AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRAINING REQUIRED FOR A CONCEALED CARRY ENDORSEMENT;
CONCERNING CONCEALED HANDGUNS; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

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3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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5	SECTION 1. The introductory language of § 5-73-306, concerning the
6	places a person who possesses a license to carry a concealed handgun is
7	prohibited from carrying a concealed handgun, is amended to read as follows:
8	Except as permitted under § 5-73-322(g), a license to carry a concealed
9	handgun issued under this subchapter does not authorize a person to carry a
10	concealed handgun into:
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12	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-322(g)(2)(A), concerning the training
13	requirements for a concealed carry endorsement, is amended to read as
14	follows:
15	(2)(A) Training required under this subsection shall:
16	(i) Not be required to be renewed;
17	(ii) Consist of a course of up to eight (8) hours;
18	<u>and</u>
19	(iii) Be offered by all training instructors and at
20	all concealed carry training courses; and
21	(iv) (iii) Cost no more than a nominal reasonable
22	amount.
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24	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current introductory
26	language of Arkansas Code § 5-73-306 lacks clarity and that the current
27	requirement under Arkansas Code § 5-73-322(g)(2)(A) that training for a
28	concealed carry endorsement be offered by all training instructors and at all
29	concealed carry training courses is overly burdensome; that a concealed carry
30	training instructor should be able to determine whether he or she desires to
31	offer training for a concealed carry endorsement; and that this act is
32	immediately necessary because the current requirement has limited the number
33	of instructors who are willing to offer concealed carry training. Therefore,
34	an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary
35	for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
36	effective on:

1	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
2	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
3	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may v	eto the	
4	bill; or		
5	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto	<u>is</u>	
6	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."		
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
