**Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 206**

CONCERNING THE TERMINATION OF A PERSON'S OBLIGATION TO REGISTER AS A SEX OFFENDER;  
AND CONCERNING LIFETIME REGISTRATION FOR CERTAIN REPEAT OFFENDERS.

**Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 206**

Amend Senate Bill No. 206 as originally introduced:

Add Senator G. Stubblefield as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 2, delete lines 15 and 16, and substitute the following:  
"the obligation to register ~~to~~ in the circuit court of the county in which the sex offender resides or has last resided within this state."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 32 through 36

AND

Page 3, delete line 1, and substitute the following:  
"(C) If the sex offender has not been assessed in the five (5) years before making a request to terminate the obligation to register under this section, the prosecuting attorney may request a reassessment and an order terminating the obligation to register shall not be granted without a reassessment."

AND

Page 3, delete line 20, and substitute the following:  
"terminate the obligation to register under this section before ~~one (1) year~~ three (3) years"
