9 AN ACT TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL TO PROVIDE
10 BLEEDING CONTROL TRAINING TO EACH STUDENT IN GRADES
11 NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12) BEFORE THE STUDENT
12 GRADUATES FROM HIGH SCHOOL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 TO REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL TO PROVIDE
16 BLEEDING CONTROL TRAINING TO EACH STUDENT
17 IN GRADES NINE THROUGH TWELVE (9-12)
18 BEFORE THE STUDENT GRADUATES FROM HIGH
19 SCHOOL.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 10, Subchapter 1, is amended
26 to add an additional section to read as follows:

27 6-10-133. Bleeding control training.

28 (a) Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, each public school shall
29 provide bleeding control training as a component of a health course to each
30 student in grades nine through twelve (9-12) before the student graduates
31 from high school.

32 (b) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the Department
33 of Health, shall develop the bleeding control training required under this
34 section using instructional materials developed or endorsed by the:

35 (1) American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma;

36 (2) National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians; or



(3) Department of Health.
