23	SECTION 1. APPR	ROPRIATION - INDUSTRIAL HEMP RESE	ARCH PROGRAM. There is
24	hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable		
25	from the Arkansas Industrial Hemp Program Fund, for personal services and		
26	operating expenses to administer the Industrial Hemp Research Program of the		
27	Arkansas Agriculture Department - State Plant Board for the fiscal year

34	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds		
35	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency		
36	and runds made availa	able by law for the support of su	ch appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 3 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 7 8 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of 21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
