8 AN ACT REGARDING THE SALARIES OF PERSONNEL AND OTHER
9 REQUIREMENTS OF VARIOUS DISTRICT COURTS; AND FOR
10 OTHER PURPOSES.

14 REGARDING THE SALARIES OF PERSONNEL AND
15 OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF VARIOUS DISTRICT
16 COURTS.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-17-108 is amended to read as follows:

22 16-17-108. Salaries of personnel and other requirements of various
23 district courts.

24 (a) Unless otherwise provided by law, the salaries of the judges and
25 other personnel of the various district courts shall be established as
26 follows:

27 (1)(A) The Arkansas County District Court – Northern District
28 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand
29 dollars (\$35,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), the
30 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen
31 thousand eight hundred thirty-four dollars and ninety-two cents (\$13,834.92)
32 ~~nor more than thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000)~~ forty-four thousand
33 dollars (\$44,000), and the deputy court clerk shall receive an annual salary
34 of not less than eleven thousand four hundred seventy-five dollars (\$11,475)
35 nor more than ~~twenty-eight~~ thirty-one thousand dollars ~~(\$28,000)~~ (\$31,000).

36 (B) The salaries shall be as determined by the governing



1 body of the City of Stuttgart and the Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid
2 one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the city and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the county;

3 (2) The Arkansas County District Court – Southern District Judge
4 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars
5 (\$25,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), the district court
6 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars
7 (\$20,000) nor more than ~~thirty-four~~ thirty-nine thousand dollars ~~(\$34,000)~~
8 (\$39,000), and the deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
9 than twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000) nor more than ~~twenty-eight~~
10 thirty-one thousand dollars ~~(\$28,000)~~ (\$31,000). The salaries shall be
11 determined by the governing body of the City of DeWitt and the Arkansas
12 County Quorum Court and paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the city and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the
13 county;

14 (3)(A) The Ashley County District Court – Crossett Department
15 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand
16 dollars (\$15,000) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000).

17 (B) The salary shall be in an amount within the range
18 prescribed in this subdivision (a)(3), as agreed upon by the Ashley County
19 Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Crossett;

20 (4)(A) The Ashley County District Court – Hamburg Department
21 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand
22 dollars (\$15,000) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000).

23 (B) The salary shall be in an amount within the range
24 prescribed in this subdivision (a)(4), as agreed upon by the Ashley County
25 Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Hamburg;

26 (5) The Baxter County District Court Clerk shall receive
27 compensation in an amount as may be provided by the City of Mountain Home and
28 the Baxter County Quorum Court. The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the
29 City of Mountain Home and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Baxter County;

30 (6)(A) The Calhoun County District Court Clerk shall receive an
31 annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more
32 than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be determined by the
33 Hampton City Council and the Calhoun County Quorum Court.

34 (B) The salary shall be paid by the City of Hampton and
35 Calhoun County in equal monthly installments;

36 (7) The Camden District Court Judge shall receive an annual

1 salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty
2 thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita
3 County;

4 (8)(A)(i) The Chicot County District Court – Dermott Department
5 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand
6 dollars (\$14,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).

7 (ii) However, the district court clerk’s position
8 may be a full-time or part-time position.

9 (B) The salary shall be in an amount within the range
10 prescribed in subdivision (a)(8)(A)(i) of this section as agreed upon by the
11 Chicot County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Dermott.

12 (C) The salary of the district court clerk shall be paid
13 as follows:

14 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
15 Dermott; and

16 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
17 County;

18 (9)(A) The Chicot County District Court – Eudora Department
19 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand
20 dollars (\$14,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).

21 (B) The salary shall be in an amount within the range
22 prescribed in subdivision (a)(9)(A) of this section as agreed upon by the
23 Chicot County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Eudora.

24 (C) The salary of the district court clerk shall be paid
25 as follows:

26 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
27 Eudora; and

28 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
29 County;

30 (10)(A)(i) The Chicot County District Court – Lake Village
31 Department Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen
32 thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).

33 (ii) If authorized by the governing body of the City
34 of Lake Village and the Chicot County Quorum Court, the district court judge
35 shall be authorized to employ a full-time or part-time deputy district court
36 clerk at an annual salary of not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) nor

1 more than twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000).

2 (iii) The salaries shall be in an amount within the
3 range prescribed in this subdivision (a)(10)(A), as agreed upon by the Chicot
4 County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Lake Village.

5 (B) The salary of the district court clerk shall be paid
6 as follows:

7 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
8 Lake Village; and

9 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
10 County;

11 (11) The Clark County District Court Clerk shall receive an
12 annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) nor
13 more than forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000), to be established annually
14 by the Clark County Quorum Court. Upon approval by the Clark County Quorum
15 Court, the Clark County District Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy
16 district court clerk to receive a salary as established by the Clark County
17 Quorum Court;

18 (12)(A) The Clay County District Court Judge shall receive an
19 annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) nor more
20 than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid, as well as other current
21 benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.

22 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
23 by the City of Corning, the City of Piggott, and the City of Rector at
24 eighteen and five-tenths percent (18.5%), eighteen and five-tenths percent
25 (18.5%), and thirteen percent (13%), respectively, to the county treasury.

26 (C) The clerks of the respective district courts shall
27 receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars
28 (\$4,500) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), to be paid, as
29 well as other current benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.

30 (D) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
31 by the respective cities;

32 (13) The Cleveland County District Court Clerk shall receive an
33 annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more
34 than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be determined by the
35 Rison City Council and the Cleveland County Quorum Court;

36 (14) The Columbia County District Court Judge shall receive an

1 annual salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor
2 more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). Any salaries paid over the
3 minimum salaries set in this subdivision (a)(14) shall be paid only upon the
4 approval of the governing bodies of the City of Magnolia and Columbia County;

5 (15)(A) The Conway County District Court Judge shall receive an
6 annual salary of not less than thirty-two thousand five hundred dollars
7 (\$32,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000).

8 (B) However, the salary may be increased by such an amount
9 as may be agreed to by the Conway County Quorum Court and the governing body
10 of the City of Morrilton by ordinances adopted by their respective bodies;

11 (16)(A) The Craighead County District Court Judge shall maintain
12 dockets and hold court, as deemed necessary, in each of the county seats of
13 Craighead County and may establish dockets and hold court in other cities and
14 towns in Craighead County, as deemed necessary by ordinance adopted by the
15 Craighead County Quorum Court.

16 (B) Necessary expenses appropriated for the Craighead
17 County District Court shall be apportioned among and paid to the county from
18 the respective cities of the first class and cities of the second class,
19 incorporated towns, and the government of Craighead County as a prorated
20 amount based on the number of cases filed from each of the towns and cities
21 and the county during the preceding calendar year;

22 (17)(A) The Cross County District Court Judge shall receive an
23 annual salary of not less than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000) nor
24 more than forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000).

25 (B) This salary and the salaries of all court employees
26 shall be as determined by the governing body of the City of Wynne;

27 (18) The Dallas County District Court Clerks shall receive an
28 annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more
29 than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), as may be determined by the
30 Fordyce City Council and the Dallas County Quorum Court, and the salaries
31 shall be paid by the City of Fordyce and Dallas County in equal monthly
32 installments;

33 (19)(A) The Desha County District Court – Dumas Department Clerk
34 shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand dollars
35 (\$18,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and the deputy
36 district clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen

1 *thousand five hundred dollars (\$14,500) nor more than ~~twenty-three thousand~~*
2 *~~dollars (\$23,000) twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000).~~*

3 (B) The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the Desha
4 County Quorum Court and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Dumas and shall be
5 determined by the Desha County Quorum Court and the governing body of the
6 City of Dumas;

7 (20) The Desha County District Court – McGehee Department Clerk
8 shall be employed and paid by the City of McGehee at such a salary as the
9 governing body of the City of McGehee shall determine;

10 (21) The East Camden District Court Judge shall receive an
11 annual salary of not less than three thousand eight hundred fifty-nine
12 dollars (\$3,859) nor more than twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000), to be
13 paid by the City of East Camden;

14 (22) The Washington County District Court – Elkins Department
15 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars
16 (\$10,000) nor more than ~~forty~~ fifty thousand dollars ~~(\$40,000)~~ (\$50,000);

17 (23)(A) The Franklin County District Court – Charleston District
18 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars
19 (\$10,000) nor more than ~~thirty~~ forty thousand dollars ~~(\$30,000)~~ (\$40,000).

20 (B) The salaries and costs may be set and the payment may
21 be apportioned by agreement between the governing body of the City of
22 Charleston and the Franklin County Quorum Court;

23 (24)(A) The Franklin County District Court – Ozark District
24 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand six
25 hundred dollars (\$22,600) nor more than ~~forty~~ fifty thousand dollars
26 ~~(\$40,000)~~ (\$50,000).

27 (B) The salary and costs may be set and the payment of the
28 salary and costs may be apportioned by agreement between the governing body
29 of the City of Ozark and the Franklin County Quorum Court;

30 (25)(A)(i) The Fulton County District Court Judge shall receive
31 an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor
32 more than forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000).

33 (ii) The annual salary of the Fulton County District
34 Court Clerk shall be not less than seventeen thousand seven hundred forty-
35 eight dollars (\$17,748) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000).

36 (B)(i) The expense of salaries, along with all other

1 necessary and customary expenses of the court, shall be shared by Fulton
2 County, the City of Salem, and the City of Mammoth Spring, based on a
3 percentage of the actual number of cases handled through the court for each
4 governmental entity.

5 (ii) The percentage shall be determined annually by
6 dividing the total number of cases handled by the district court into the
7 number of cases handled annually for each of the aforementioned governmental
8 entities.

9 (iii) On January 1 of each year, each share shall be
10 estimated based on the number of cases handled by the district court for each
11 of the respective governmental entities for the preceding year.

12 (iv) However, on December 31 of each year, each
13 share shall be adjusted to reflect the actual percentage for each
14 governmental entity for that year based on the actual case load.

15 (C) The salaries and expenses shall be paid in equal
16 monthly installments by Fulton County, and the City of Salem and the City of
17 Mammoth Spring shall reimburse the county on a monthly basis for their
18 respective shares of salaries and expenses;

19 (26)(A) The Garland County District Court Judges, Departments 1
20 and 2, each shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixty-five
21 thousand dollars (\$65,000) nor more than ninety-five thousand dollars
22 (\$95,000), and the Garland County District Court Clerk shall receive an
23 annual salary of not less than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000) nor more
24 than ~~fifty-seven thousand dollars (\$57,000)~~ sixty-eight thousand four hundred
25 dollars (\$68,400).

26 (B) The salaries shall be determined by the governing body
27 of the City of Hot Springs and the Garland County Quorum Court;

28 (27)(A) The Grant County District Court Clerk shall receive an
29 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more
30 than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000), as approved by the Grant County
31 Quorum Court.

32 (B) The district court clerk's salary shall be paid as
33 follows:

34 (i) Twenty-seven percent (27%) to be paid by the
35 City of Sheridan; and

36 (ii) Seventy-three percent (73%) to be paid by Grant

1 County;

2 (28)(A) The Greene County District Court – Paragould District
3 Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than nineteen thousand eight
4 hundred fifty-six dollars (\$19,856) nor more than ~~forty~~ fifty thousand
5 dollars ~~(\$40,000)~~ (\$50,000), the chief deputy district court clerk shall
6 receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand six hundred
7 twenty-four dollars (\$16,624) nor more than ~~thirty-five~~ forty thousand
8 dollars ~~(\$35,000)~~ (\$40,000), and the deputy district court clerk shall
9 receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand three hundred
10 fourteen dollars (\$13,314) nor more than ~~thirty-two~~ thirty-five thousand
11 dollars ~~(\$32,000)~~ (\$35,000).

12 (B) The salaries shall be determined by the Greene County
13 Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Paragould and shall be
14 paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments;

15 (29)(A) The Hempstead County District Court Clerk shall receive
16 an annual salary of not less than ~~twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000)~~
17 thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000) nor more than ~~thirty thousand dollars~~
18 ~~(\$30,000)~~ forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000).

19 (B) The amount of the salary shall be determined by
20 agreement between the governing body of the City of Hope and the Hempstead
21 County Quorum Court;

22 (30) The Hot Spring County – Malvern Department District Court
23 Judge shall be entitled to an additional deputy district court clerk whose
24 salary shall be determined by the governing body of the City of Malvern and
25 the Hot Spring County Quorum Court, and the salary shall be paid by the city
26 and county in the same proportion as the city and county shared in the
27 revenues generated by the court in the previous year;

28 (31)(A)(i) The Howard County District Court Judge shall have an
29 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000).

30 (ii) The Howard County District Court Clerk shall
31 receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000)
32 nor more than nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000), unless provided for
33 otherwise by ordinance of the Howard County Quorum Court and the governing
34 body of the City of Nashville.

35 (B) The salaries are to be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City
36 of Nashville and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Howard County;

1 (32)(A) The IZARD County District Court Judge shall receive an
2 annual salary of not less than ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,200) nor
3 more than forty-two thousand dollars (\$42,000), and the district court clerk
4 shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand four hundred
5 dollars (\$7,400) nor more than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000).

6 (B) However, the salaries shall be subject to the approval
7 of the Melbourne City Council and the IZARD County Quorum Court;

8 (33)(A) The JACKSON County District Court Judge shall receive an
9 annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) nor
10 more than fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000).

11 (B) The salary of the district court judge shall be paid
12 one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Newport and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by JACKSON County;

13 (34) The JACKSONVILLE District Court Clerk shall receive an
14 annual salary of not less than thirty-three thousand nine hundred thirty-
15 seven dollars (\$33,937) nor more than thirty-six thousand nine hundred
16 dollars (\$36,900);

17 (35)(A) ~~The Newton County District Court - Jasper District Court~~
18 ~~Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand~~
19 ~~dollars (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars~~
20 ~~(\$22,500), and the Department district court clerk shall receive an annual~~
21 ~~salary of not less than thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) twenty-eight~~
22 ~~thousand six hundred dollars (\$28,600) nor more than eighteen thousand~~
23 ~~dollars (\$18,000) thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000).~~

24 (B) All salaries and all other expenses of the office
25 shall be paid one hundred percent (100%) by the county;

26 (36) The JEFFERSON County District Court clerks for Division 1
27 and Division 2 shall receive annual salaries of not less than thirty-one
28 thousand dollars (\$31,000) nor more than ~~fifty-three~~ fifty-four thousand
29 dollars ~~(\$53,000)~~ (\$54,000), as may be approved by the Jefferson County
30 Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Pine Bluff;

31 (37)(A) The JOHNSON County District Court Judge shall receive an
32 annual salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more
33 than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).

34 (B) This expense, as well as all other expenses related to
35 the operation of the JOHNSON County District Court, is to be divided among
36 the county and all cities within the county based on the percentage of the

1 total fine money collected during the year by each participating entity;

2 (38)(A) The Lafayette County – Lewisville Department District
3 Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two
4 thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars
5 (\$35,000), and the City of Lewisville shall pay to the district court clerk
6 at least eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$8,800) but not more than
7 fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) of the salary, and Lafayette County shall
8 pay to the district court clerk not less than thirteen thousand two hundred
9 dollars (\$13,200) but not more than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) of
10 the salary.

11 (B) The amount and manner of payment of the salary of the
12 district court clerk may be established within the ranges specified in
13 subdivision (a)(38)(A) of this section by mutual agreement of the Lafayette
14 County Quorum Court and the Lewisville City Council, as well as the amount
15 and manner of payment of all other expenses of operation of the Lafayette
16 County – Lewisville Department District Court;

17 (39)(A) The Lawrence County District Court – Hoxie Department
18 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand seven
19 hundred forty dollars (\$13,740) nor more than twenty thousand dollars
20 (\$20,000), to be paid by the City of Hoxie and approved by its governing
21 body.

22 (B) The Lawrence County District Court – Walnut Ridge
23 Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifty-one
24 thousand dollars (\$51,000) nor more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000),
25 one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the salary to be paid by the City of Walnut Ridge and the
26 other one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) to be paid by Lawrence County;

27 (40)(A) The Little River County District Court Judge shall
28 receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-two thousand eight hundred
29 dollars (\$32,800) nor more than sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000), as
30 determined by the governing body of the City of Ashdown and the Little River
31 County Quorum Court.

32 (B) The salary shall be paid sixty-two percent (62%) by
33 Little River County and thirty-eight percent (38%) by the City of Ashdown,
34 unless otherwise agreed by the Little River County Quorum Court and the
35 governing body of the City of Ashdown;

36 (41) The Logan County District Court – Northern District Judge

1 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars
2 (\$22,000) nor more than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000), as may be
3 determined by the Paris City Council and the Logan County Quorum Court and
4 shall be payable one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Paris and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Logan
5 County and shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments;

6 (42) The Logan County District Court – Southern District Judge
7 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars
8 (\$22,000) nor more than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000), as may be
9 determined by the Booneville City Council and the Logan County Quorum Court
10 and shall be payable one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Booneville and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
11 by Logan County and shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments;

12 (43) The Lonoke County District Court – Northern District Cabot
13 Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-five
14 thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), as
15 may be determined by the governing body of the City of Cabot;

16 (44) The Lonoke County District Court – Northern District Ward
17 Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-five
18 thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), as
19 may be determined by the governing body of the City of Ward;

20 (45) The Lonoke County District Court – Southern District
21 Carlisle Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than
22 four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) nor more than twenty-five
23 thousand dollars (\$25,000);

24 (46) The Lonoke County District Court – Southern District
25 England Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than four
26 thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) nor more than twenty-five thousand
27 dollars (\$25,000);

28 (47)(A) The Lonoke County District Court – Southern District
29 Lonoke Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than five
30 thousand dollars (\$5,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars
31 (\$25,000), as may be determined by the governing body of the City of Lonoke.

32 (B)(i) Necessary expenses appropriated by the City of
33 Lonoke for the district court shall be apportioned among and paid to the City
34 of Lonoke by the cities of the first class, cities of the second class,
35 incorporated towns, and the county as a prorated amount based on the number
36 of cases filed from each of the cities of the first class, cities of the

1 second class, incorporated towns, and the county during the preceding year.

2 (ii) An itemized bill shall be prepared by the City
3 of Lonoke fixing the apportioned expenses, and payment shall be made no later
4 than sixty (60) days following the submission by the City of Lonoke of the
5 bills;

6 (48)(A) The Maumelle District Court Clerk shall receive an
7 annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand five hundred dollars
