15	(b)(1) The rules shall require training programs to:		
16	(A) Provide no fewer than ninety (90) clock hours of		
17	training; and		
18	(B) Include in those ninety (90) clock hours no fewer than		
19	fifteen (15) clock hours of training specific to Alzheimer's disease and		
20	related dementia; and		
21	(C) Have only one (1) primary instructor for each course.
