3	ventilatory function is often impaired;
4	(C) The patient may require assistance in maintaining a
5	patent airway and positive pressure ventilation may be required because of
6	depressed spontaneous ventilation or drug-induced depression of neuromuscular
7	function; and
8	(D) The patient's cardiovascular function may be impaired;
9	(3) "Minimal sedation" means a drug-induced state during which:
10	(A) The patient responds normally to verbal commands;
11	(B) The patient's cognitive function and coordination may
12	be impaired; and
13	(C) The patient's ventilatory and cardiovascular functions
14	are unaffected;
15	(4) "Minor procedure" means:
16	(A) A procedure that can be performed safely with a
17	minimum of discomfort where the likelihood of complications requiring
18	hospitalization is minimal;
19	(B) A procedure performed with local or topical
20	anesthesia; and
21	(C) Liposuction with removal of less than five hundred
22	cubic centimeters (500 cc) of fat under nonsupplemented local anesthesia;
23	(5) "Moderate sedation" means a drug-induced state during which:
24	(A) The patient responds purposefully to verbal commands,
25	either alone or in response to light tactile stimulation;
26	(B) An intervention is not required to maintain a patent
27	airway;
28	(C) The patient maintains a patent airway and spontaneous
29	ventilation is adequate; and
30	(D) The patient's cardiovascular function may be
31	maintained without assistance;
32	(6)(A) "Office-based surgery" means any surgical or other
33	invasive procedure that requires general anesthesia, moderate sedation, or
34	deep sedation.
35	(B) "Office-based surgery" does not include minor
36	procedures or procedures requiring minimal sedation;

1	(7)(A) "Outpatient surgery center" means the same as in § 20-9-
2	<u>201(9).</u>
3	(B) "Outpatient surgery center" does not include a
4	hospital; and
5	(8)(A) "Surgical clinic" includes:
6	(i) A medical office owned and operated by a
7	physician or more than one (1) physician licensed by the Arkansas State
8	Medical Board, if the medical office does not bill facility fees to a third
9	party payor; or
10	(ii) A dental office that has a Moderate Sedation
11	Facility Permit or a Deep Sedation-General Anesthesia Facility Permit issued
12	by the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners.
13	(B) "Surgical clinic" does not include a hospital.
14	(b) When performing office-based surgery, an outpatient surgery center
15	shall report to the Department of Health within three (3) business days the
16	occurrence of:
17	(1) A surgically related death and all events related to the
18	procedure that resulted in the death; and
19	(2) All events related to a procedure that results in:
20	(A) An emergency transfer of a surgical patient to a
21	hospital;
22	(B) Anesthetic or surgical events requiring
23	cardiopulmonary resuscitation;
24	(C) Unscheduled hospitalization related to the surgery; or
25	(D) Surgical site deep wound infections.
26	(c) When performing office-based surgery, a surgical clinic shall
27	report to the Arkansas State Medical Board within three (3) business days the
28	occurrence of:
29	(1) A surgically related death and all events related to the
30	procedure that resulted in the death;
31	(2) All events related to a procedure that results in:
32	(A) An emergency transfer of a surgical patient to a
33	hospital;
34	(B) Anesthetic or surgical events requiring
35	cardiopulmonary resuscitation;
36	(C) Unscheduled hospitalization related to the surgery; or

1	(D) Surgical site deep wound infections.
2	(d) The reports described in subsections (b) and (c) of this section
3	shall include:
4	(1) The name of the performing physician or provider at the time
5	of the event;
6	(2) The names of any associated staff at the time of the event;
7	(3) The location where the event occurred;
8	(4) The name of the patient and other patient identifying
9	information;
10	(5) The name of the hospital or emergency center where the
11	patient is transferred, if applicable;
12	(6) The type of office-based surgery performed;
13	(7) The date and time of the office-based surgery and the event;
14	<u>and</u>
15	(8) A detailed description of the event.
16	(e)(1) An outpatient surgery center shall establish and maintain an
17	infection prevention, surveillance, and control program as required by rules
18	of the State Board of Health.
19	(2) A surgical clinic shall establish and maintain an infection
20	surveillance program as necessary to ensure the discovery and reporting of
21	infections required under subsection (c) of this section.
22	(f) Information reported under subsections (c) and (d) of this section
23	shall not be disclosed publicly in such manner as to identify a patient.
24	(g)(1) The department and Arkansas State Medical Board shall
25	promulgate rules to implement this section.
26	(2)(A) When adopting the initial rules to implement this
27	subchapter, the final rules shall be filed with the Secretary of State for
28	adoption under § 25-15-204(f):
29	(i) On or before January 1, 2020; or
30	(ii) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred
31	by January 1, 2020, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.
32	(B) The department and Arkansas State Medical Board shall
33	file the proposed rules with the Legislative Council under § 10-3-309(c)
34	sufficiently in advance of January 1, 2020, so that the Legislative Council
35	may consider the rule for approval before January 1, 2020.
36	(h)(1) The department shall enforce the requirements of this section

	through the licensure and survey process for outpatient surgery centers.
2	(2)(A) The Arkansas State Medical Board shall assess a fine of
3	no less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) per violation against
4	a physician who controls or operates a surgical clinic that fails to comply
5	with the requirements of this section.
6	(B) Each day of noncompliance is a separate violation.
7	(i) In an emergency, appropriate life-support measures shall take
8	precedence over the requirements of this subchapter.
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
