25 WHEREAS, section 38.(o)(a) of the Rules of the House of Representatives
26 of the Ninety-Second General Assembly states that "Any proposed legislation
27 affecting any publicly supported retirement system or pension plan to be
28 considered by the General Assembly at a regular session shall be introduced
29 in the General Assembly during the first fifteen (15) calendar days of a
30 regular session.";

32 WHEREAS, Section 38.(o)(b) of the Rules of the House of Representatives
33 of the Ninety-Second General Assembly states that "No such bill shall be
34 introduced after the fifteenth day of a regular session unless its
35 introduction is first approved by a three-fourths (3/4) vote of the full
36 membership of each House of the General Assembly."; and

WHEREAS, the bill that will create the Transformation and Efficiencies Act of 2019 may affect publicly supported retirement systems or pension plans,

NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT sections 38.(o)(a) and 38.(o)(b) of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Second General Assembly are hereby suspended in order to allow Representative Andy Davis and Senator Bart Hester to introduce a bill creating the Transformation and Efficiencies Act of 2019 on a date after the fifteenth calendar day of the 2019 Regular Session.
