19 WHEREAS, in 2011, the General Assembly passed and the Governor signed
20 Acts 2011, No. 570, which lowered sentences for controlled substances
21 offenses in certain cases; and

22

23 WHEREAS, however, Acts 2011, No. 570, was not retroactive, and
24 therefore offenders sentenced for the same offense before the effective date
25 of Acts 2011, No. 570, were subjected to a higher level of criminal liability
26 for the same conduct than those who were sentenced after the effective date
27 of Acts 2011, No. 570, and this has often led to some inmates serving much
28 longer sentences than other inmates who were convicted of the same offense;

31 WHEREAS, the Parole Board has considered this lack of equity in
32 sentences and parole eligibility dates and has begun to offer recommendations
33 to Governor Asa Hutchinson in certain cases that attempt to resolve this
34 inequity,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
2 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

4 THAT the Senate encourages and urges Governor Asa Hutchinson to act as
5 expeditiously as possible on the recommendations by the Parole Board
6 concerning controlled substances convictions that were imposed prior to Acts
7 2011, No. 570, and resulted in sentences longer than those imposed for the
8 same conduct after Acts 2011, No. 570.
