17	(d)(1) If revenues collected under this section exceed the costs of		
18	operating the program established by § 20-79-401 et seq., and if the excess		
19	at any time equals a three-year average of expenditures under this section		
20	and § 20-79-401 et seq., then the collection of the surcharge shall cease		
21	until one-half (½) of the surplus has been exhausted At the close of the		
22	fiscal year, a determination shall be made as to whether or not the amount of		
23	revenues collected under this section is equal to or exceeds three (3) times		
24	the annual expenditures of the equipment distribution program.		
25	(2)(A) If the amount of revenues collected under this section is		
26	determined to be at least three (3) times the annual expenditures of the		
27	equipment distribution program under subdivision (d)(1) of this section, then		
28	a petition to cease collection of the surcharge shall be filed with the		
29	commission.		
30	(B) A petition to reinstate collection of the surcharge		
31	shall not be filed until one-half $(1/2)$ of the surplus has been exhausted.
