16	county and municipal officers, is amended to read as follows:		
17	(d) If one (1) of the two (2) candidates who received the highest		
18	number of votes for a county elected office or a municipal office but not a		
19	majority of the votes in a county for a county elected office or either a		
20	majority or both forty percent (40%) of the votes cast and at least twenty		
21	percent (20%) more of the votes cast than the second-place candidate the		
22	highest number of votes for a municipal elected office but not a majority of		
23	the votes in a municipality for a municipal office in the general election		
24	withdraws before certification of the result of the general election, the		
25	remaining candidate who received the most votes at the general election shall		
26	be declared elected to the county elected office or municipal office and		
27	there shall be no runoff general election.
