23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-23-112(b), concerning the
26 disqualification of a commercial vehicle driver convicted of major offenses,
27 is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

28 (8) If a driver operates a commercial motor vehicle and is
29 convicted of using the commercial motor vehicle in the commission of a felony
30 involving a severe form of trafficking in persons as defined in 22 U.S.C. §
31 7102(11), as in effect on January 1, 2021, the driver shall be disqualified
32 from operating a commercial motor vehicle for life and shall not be eligible
33 for reinstatement after ten (10) years.
