"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION DIVISION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE SURPLUS PROPERTY PROGRAM WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THE APPROPRIATION IN ITEM (01),(02),(03), AND (04) OF SECTION 10 OF ACT 1051 OF 1987 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - SURPLUS PROPERTY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education Division, to be payable from the Federal Surplus Property Fund, for operating expenses of the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education Division - Surplus Property, which shall be supplemental and in addition to the appropriation in Items (01),(02),(03), and (04) of Section 10 of Act 1051 of 1987 as amended by Act 68 of 1987, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 2. Rural Water Associations shall be deemed eligible to participate in the Federal Surplus Property Program as now administered by the Vocational and Technical Education Division of the Department of Education, or any successor agency.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, meeting in the Third Extraordinary Session, that the passage of this Act is necessary to provide for continued operation of the Vocational and Technical Education Division of the State Department of Education. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
