"AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A PORTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY SEVENTY-ONE THE JOHN PAUL HAMMERSCHMIDT HIGHWAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

- SECTION 1. (a) U.S. Highway 71 from the I-40 intersection to the Missouri line shall be designated as the John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway within the State of Arkansas.
- (b) It shall be the responsibility of the State Highway and Transportation Department to place appropriate highway identifying signs on the highway.
- (c) The department shall erect appropriate signs along the section of the highway designated herein, indicating that the highway has been designated the John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway.
- SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the new U.S. Highway 71 under construction during the 77th Session of the Arkansas General Assembly.
- SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
- SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
