SENATE BILL 1

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS SENATE WHICH SHALL BE
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
11 BY ACT 2 OF 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS SENATE
15 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
20 Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for
21 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Senate which shall be
22 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 2
23 of 1995, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the
24 following:

25 (1) Personal Services and Operating Expenses, the sum of\$120,000.00.

27 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
33 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
34 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
4 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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10 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
11 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
12 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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14 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
15 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
16 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
17 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
18 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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20 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
21 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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23 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
24 Eightieth General Assembly meeting in the First Extraordinary Session, that
25 funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Arkansas
26 Senate are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas
27 Senate to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the
28 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
29 Senate to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
30 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
31 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
32 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
33 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
34 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
