A Bill

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS HOUSE OF
10 REPRESENTATIVES WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1 OF 1995; AND
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS HOUSE OF
16 REPRESENTATIVES SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the Constitutional
23 Officers Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas
24 House of Representatives which shall be supplemental and in addition to those
25 funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 1 of 1995, for the remainder of the
26 biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the following:

- 27 (1) Personal Services and Operating Expenses \$200,000.00.

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29 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
30 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
31 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
32 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
35 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
36 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

1 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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3 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
4 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
5 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
6 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
7 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
8 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
10 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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12 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
13 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
14 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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16 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
17 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
18 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
19 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
20 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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22 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
23 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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25 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
26 Eightieth General Assembly meeting in the First Extraordinary Session, that
27 funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Arkansas
28 House of Representatives are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient
29 for the Arkansas House of Representatives to continue to provide essential
30 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
31 necessary monies for the Arkansas House of Representatives to continue such
32 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
33 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
34 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
35 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
