8	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
9	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the law does not provide		
10	subpoena power for the State Board of Education or the Professional Licensure		
11	Standards Board; that the State Board of Education and the Professional		
12	Licensure Standards Board are unable to fully implement their duties due to		
13	lack of subpoena. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act		
14	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,		
15	and safety shall become effective on:		
16	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
17	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
18	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
19	bill; or		
20	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
21	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
