21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-422(b), concerning the membership of
24 the Professional Licensure Standards Board, is amended to read as follows:

25 (b)(1) The Professional Licensure Standards Board shall consist
26 of fifteen (15) members appointed by the State Board of Education as follows:

27 ~~(1)~~ (A) The Commissioner of Education or his or her
28 designee, who shall serve as a nonvoting member ~~and chair~~;

29 ~~(2)(A)~~ (B)(i) Four (4) public school classroom
30 teachers with a valid Arkansas teaching license who are recommended by the
31 Arkansas Education Association.

32 ~~(B)~~ (ii) The four (4) public school classroom
33 teachers shall represent the four (4) congressional districts in Arkansas and
34 include classroom teachers who are licensed and teach at:

35 ~~(i)~~ (a) A licensure level of prekindergarten



1 through grade four (preK-4);

2 ~~(ii)~~ (b) A licensure level of grades four

3 through eight (4-8);

4 ~~(iii)~~ (c) A licensure level of grades seven

5 through twelve (7-12); and

6 ~~(iv)~~ (d) Any licensure level to serve in one

7 (1) at-large position;

8 ~~(3)~~ (C) Four (4) persons with valid Arkansas teaching and

9 administrator's licenses who represent the four (4) congressional districts

10 in Arkansas and are:

11 ~~(A)~~ (i) Recommended by the Arkansas Association of

12 Educational Administrators;

13 ~~(B)~~ (ii) One (1) of whom shall hold a P-8 building

14 level leader license and serve as a middle-level building leader;

15 ~~(C)~~ (iii) Two (2) of whom shall be public school

16 superintendents with valid Arkansas teaching and administrator's licenses

17 recommended by the Arkansas Association of School Administrators; and

18 ~~(D)~~ (iv) One (1) public school administrator with a

19 valid Arkansas teaching and administrator's license recommended by the

20 Arkansas Association of School Personnel Administrators;

21 ~~(4)~~ (D) One (1) nonvoting representative designated by the

22 Department of Education from its offices of licensure and teacher quality

23 recommended by the commissioner;

24 ~~(5)~~~~(A)~~ (E)(i) Three (3) deans of education from Arkansas

25 institutions of higher education recommended by the Arkansas Association of

26 Colleges for Teacher Education.

27 ~~(B)~~~~(i)~~ (ii)(a) One (1) dean shall be from a private

28 institution of higher education.

29 ~~(ii)~~ (b) One (1) dean shall be from a public

30 institution of higher education.

31 ~~(iii)~~ (c) One (1) ~~of whom shall have~~ dean who

32 has knowledge of licensure issues;

33 ~~(6)~~ (F) One (1) coordinator of educational leadership

34 recommended by the Arkansas Professors of Educational Administration; and

35 ~~(7)~~ (G) One (1) curriculum program administrator

36 recommended by the Arkansas Association of Supervision and Curriculum

1 Development.

2 (2)(A) The voting members of the Professional Licensure Standards
 3 Board shall elect annually one (1) of the voting members to serve as chair
 4 for one (1) year.

5 (B) The chair shall serve as a nonvoting member during his
 6 or her term as chair, however the chair may vote in the case of a tie.

7
 8 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-422(c)(1), concerning the appointment
 9 of members of the Professional Licensure Standards Board, is amended to read
 10 as follows:

11 (c)(1) The State Board of Education shall consider all recommendations
 12 under ~~subsection (b)~~ subdivision (b)(1) of this section submitted to the
 13 secretary of the State Board of Education by June 30, 2007, for the initial
 14 board and by June 30 of each year in which the term of a Professional
 15 Licensure Standards Board member expires.

 17 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-17-422(e), concerning the organizational
 18 meeting of the Professional Licensure Standards Board, is amended to read as
 19 follows:

20 (e)~~(1)~~ The appointed members of the Professional Licensure Standards
 21 Board shall be residents of this state at the time of appointment and
 22 throughout their terms.

23 ~~(2) The commissioner or his or her designee shall call an~~
 24 ~~organizational meeting within twenty (20) calendar days after the State Board~~
 25 ~~of Education has made all necessary appointments.~~

26
 27 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-17-422(h)(3)(D), concerning the
 28 Professional Licensure Standards Board procedures relating to the code of
 29 ethics, is amended to read as follows:

30 (D)(i) The Professional Licensure Standards Board may:

31 ~~(i)~~(a) Establish procedures for receiving,
 32 considering, and investigating complaints referred by the Department of
 33 Education, a public school district, or a public school superintendent
 34 regarding the unethical behavior of licensed school personnel;

35 ~~(ii)~~(b) Make recommendations for enforcement; and

36 ~~(iii)~~(c) Establish an ethics subcommittee of the

1 Professional Licensure Standards Board with equal representation of public
2 school teachers and administrators as well as one (1) member from any other
3 category of representation on the Professional Licensure Standards Board.

4 (ii) All rules, procedures, hearings, and appeals
5 relating to the code of ethics required by this subsection (h) are subject to
6 the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.
