20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 22-6-305 is amended to read as follows to
23 correct the classification of a criminal offense pursuant to § 5-1-107(a)(2)
24 and § 5-1-108(b) and to correct word usage:

25 22-6-305. Certification of purchase money – Penalty.

26 (a) ~~Each county clerk shall, immediately~~ Immediately after each sale
27 of any part of school lands and lots under this subchapter, each county clerk
28 shall certify to the Auditor of State the amount of moneys received by the
29 sheriff on account of the sale, and the Auditor of State shall charge this
30 amount to the sheriff.

31 (b) ~~Any neglect~~ Neglect, failure, or refusal by any county clerk to
32 perform ~~any and all~~ duties enjoined upon him or her by ~~the provisions of this~~
33 section ~~shall be deemed a misdemeanor~~ is a violation, and upon conviction,
34 the county clerk shall be fined in any sum not less than one hundred dollars
35 (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense and may be
36 removed from office.



SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. CONSTRUCTION AND LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

It is the intent of the General Assembly that:

(1) The enactment and adoption of this act shall not expressly or impliedly repeal an act passed during the regular session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly;

(2) To the extent that a conflict exists between an act of the regular session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly and this act:

(A) The act of the regular session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly shall be treated as a subsequent act passed by the General Assembly for the purposes of:

(i) Giving the act of the regular session of the Ninety-Fourth General Assembly its full force and effect; and

(ii) Amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987; and

(B) Section 1-2-107 shall not apply; and

(3) This act shall make only technical, not substantive, changes to the Arkansas Code of 1987.
