## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE -  
16 ARKANSAS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Department of Commerce - Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2024-  
26 2025 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

16 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department  
 17 of Commerce - Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2024-2025 fiscal  
 18 year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be  
 19 known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
 20 purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates  
 21 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 22 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 23 classification.

25 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 26 to the Department of Commerce, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
 27 Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for personal services, operating expenses, data  
 28 processing services and grants and aid by the Department of Commerce -  
 29 Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30,

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - NATIONAL HOUSING TRUST FUND GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Commerce - Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses for implementation of the Federal Housing Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the following:

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS HOUSING TRUST FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Commerce, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for a grant or transfer to the Arkansas Housing Trust Fund to provide assistance for eligible activities proposed by eligible applicants, including without limitation grants, loans, loan guarantees, and loan subsidies of the Department of Commerce - Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the following:

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3  
 4 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 6 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 7 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

 13 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 14 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
 15 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of  
 17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 18 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm  
 20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 23 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
