Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1409

Amend House Bill No. 1409 as originally introduced:

Hodges, Hollowell, Lundstrum, McCullough, McNair, Miller, Payton, Richardson, Richmond, Scott, B. Smith, Warren, Wing as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Add Senators Elliott, E. Cheatham, L. Eads, M. Johnson, G. Stubblefield as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Page 2, line 10, delete "kindergarten through grade five" and substitute "elementary"

AND

Page 2, line 11, delete "(K-5)"

AND

Page 2, delete line 24, and substitute the following:

"(ii) Occur outdoors when weather and other relevant conditions permit; and"

AND

Page 2, line 26, delete "activity" and substitute "activity, regardless of



whether recess occurs indoors or outdoors"

AND

Page 2, delete line 29, and substitute the following:

"public school district board of directors.

(D) A public school principal may use discretion to adjust recess time required under this section due to special circumstances or programs that interrupt a regular school day.

(E) The requirements under this subdivision (a)(5) of this section shall not be waived by the department or by the State Board of Education."
