**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

10:1 ratio for administrators during synchronous test administration would require additional staff and may be problematic with testing within the set window. Currently, test administrator must be licensed or have a 1240 waiver or emergency teaching permit. That was established to comply with vendor requirements and ensure test security and reliable/valid data.

The requirement for a lock down browser will require students to use two computers during testing – one to test with and one to monitor.
