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30 WHEREAS, public school administrators, principals, and teachers who
31 function as a professional community strengthen the intellectual quality of
32 instruction and thereby increase student achievement; and
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34 WHEREAS, the General Assembly would like to enhance the state's
35 leadership training program and develop an exemplary system for delivering
36 leadership training to public school leaders statewide,

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NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the House Interim Committee on Education and the Senate Interim Committee on Education conduct a study to determine the essential components of an exemplary Leadership program for school Leaders statewide.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is directed to develop an exemplary system of Leadership training for principals, administrators, and teachers in public schools and school districts to be administered in conjunction with the Arkansas Leadership Academy School Support Program, Arkansas Code § 6-15-440.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department shall report on the progress of the program development on a regular basis to the House Interim Committee on Education and the Senate Interim Committee on Education.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that before March 1, 2008, the Department of Education shall present to the House Interim Committee on Education and the Senate Interim Committee on Education its plan to implement the program beginning with the 2007-2008 school year and the funding necessary to implement the program.

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
