12 AN ACT REGARDING THE ARKANSAS NATURAL RESOURCES
13 COMMISSION; TO ESTABLISH THE WATER AND SEWER
14 TREATMENT FACILITIES GRANT PROGRAM; TO CREATE THE
15 WATER AND SEWER TREATMENT FACILITIES GRANT PROGRAM
16 FUND; TO TRANSFER FUNDING FROM THE SECURITIES RESERVE
17 FUND; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER
18 PURPOSES.

21 Subtitle

22 TO ESTABLISH THE WATER AND SEWER
23 TREATMENT FACILITIES GRANT PROGRAM; TO
24 TRANSFER FUNDING FROM THE SECURITIES
25 RESERVE FUND; AND TO DECLARE AN
26 EMERGENCY.

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29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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31 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-5-905(a)(11) and (12), concerning the
32 use of the Securities Reserve Fund, are amended to read as follows:

33 (11) After the transfer enumerated in subdivision (a)(10) of
34 this section and contingent upon available moneys in the Securities Reserve
35 Fund, for a transfer by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State of fifty

1 million dollars (\$50,000,000) or as much as remains unobligated each fiscal
2 year to the Water and Sewer Treatment Facilities Grant Program Fund;

3 (12) For a transfer by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State on
4 the last business day of the fiscal year to the Budget Stabilization Trust
5 Fund to reimburse the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund for any current fiscal
6 year transfers that have been made to the following:

7 (A) The Division of Correction Farm Fund under § 19-5-
8 501(b)(1);

9 (B) The Department of the Military Fund Account under §
10 19-5-501(b)(3);

11 (C) The Disaster Assistance Fund under § 19-5-1006;

12 (D) The Miscellaneous Revolving Fund under § 19-5-1009;

13 (E) The State Central Services Fund under § 19-5-501(d);

14 and

15 (F) The State Board of Election Commissioners, as
16 authorized by law; and

17 ~~(12)~~(13) After all distributions and transfers under this
18 section, less one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) under § 19-3-521(a)(2),
19 for a transfer by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State on the last business
20 day of the fiscal year of the fund balance to the Catastrophic Reserve Fund.

22 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 6, Subchapter 8, is amended
23 to add an additional section to read as follows:

24 19-6-844. Water and Sewer Treatment Facilities Grant Program Fund.

25 (a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
26 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue
27 fund to be known as the "Water and Sewer Treatment Facilities Grant Program
28 Fund".

29 (b) The fund shall consist of:

30 (1) Moneys transferred to the fund under § 19-5-905; and

31 (2) Any other revenues as authorized by law.

32 (c) The fund shall be used by the Arkansas Natural Resources
33 Commission to award grants under the Water and Sewer Treatment Facilities
34 Grant Program established in § 25-43-203.

1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 43, Subchapter 2, is
2 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

3 25-43-203. Water and Sewer Treatment Facilities Grant Program.

4 (a)(1) There is created within the Arkansas Natural Resources
5 Commission the Water and Sewer Treatment Facilities Grant Program to be
6 administered by the commission.

7 (2) The commission may hire personnel necessary to carry out the
8 duties of administering the program.

9 (b) The commission shall:

10 (1) Create an application form to be submitted by eligible water
11 and sewer treatment facilities seeking a matching grant from the program;

12 (2) Devise an application process that:

13 (A) Defines the eligibility criteria for a matching grant;
14 and

15 (B) Establishes application submittal and review
16 processes;

17 (3) Define a process by which matching grants may be awarded;

18 (4) Execute standard legal grant agreements and other
19 documentation governing the disbursement and use of matching grants; and

20 (5) Provide matching grants to eligible water and sewer
21 treatment facilities for infrastructure and improvement projects that are
22 shovel ready.

23 (c) The commission shall promulgate rules necessary for the
24 implementation of the program.

26 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
27 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that it is in the best interest of
28 the citizens of this state to provide water and sewer grant opportunities for
29 projects to keep Arkansas water systems safe and clean; and that this act is
30 necessary because there is a dire need to protect public health and safety in
31 Arkansas by replacing water and sewer lines in disrepair and providing new
32 access to clean water systems to other citizens. Therefore, an emergency is
33 declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the
34 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
35 on:

36 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

1 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
2 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
3 bill; or

4 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
5 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
