8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES OF
9 THE GOVERNOR'S LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS DURING THE
10 NINETY-SECOND SESSION OF THE ARKANSAS GENERAL
11 ASSEMBLY FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR THE
12 FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2019; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR -
16 LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS APPROPRIATION FOR THE
17 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - LEGISLATIVE ASSISTANCE. There is hereby
24 appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the
25 Constitutional Officers Fund, for operating expenses of the Office of the
26 Governor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, the following:

32 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LIAISONS
34 AUTHORIZED. The Governor is hereby authorized to employ one (1) Lead
35 Legislative Liaison who shall serve without pay but shall be entitled to per
36 diem of up to two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) for each day the General

1 Assembly is in Regular Session and nine (9) Legislative Liaisons who shall
2 serve without pay but shall each be entitled to per diem of up to two hundred
3 dollars (\$200) for each day the General Assembly is in Regular Session. After
4 receiving approval of the Governor, the Department of Finance and
5 Administration - Management Services Division is hereby authorized to process
6 payments to said Liaisons from funds authorized by this Act.

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8 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAYMENT OF
10 PER DIEM. Per Diem as authorized in Section 2 - Liaisons Authorized of this
11 Act shall be in effect from and after January 14, 2019.

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13 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

23 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
30 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
33 Assembly that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and
34 approval is essential to the operation of the agency for which the
35 appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an
36 extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act

1 beyond the date of its passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon
2 the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
6 passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the
7 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time
8 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the
9 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date
10 the last house overrides the veto.

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
