Should additional General Revenue funds become available to the Department of Arkansas State Police, the department shall provide employees in positions authorized with the classifications listed below a 5% salary increase, effective July 1, 2019. This salary increase shall be in addition to any cost of living adjustment or performance based increase that may be provided during the 2020 Fiscal Year. If providing this salary increase to current employees would have the effect of exceeding the maximum pay level for the grade assigned to the employees classification, the additional compensation shall not be considered as exceeding the maximum allowable rate for the grade.

"SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD OF FUNDS.

- (a) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall cause to be transferred on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of State the balance of funds remaining in the State Military Department Fund Account on June 30, 2020 into a sub-fund created within the State Military Department Fund to be used exclusively for construction, maintenance and operating expenses or for future construction projects of the State Military Department.
- (b) Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:
- (1) The Office of Budget of the Department of Finance and Administration shall report to the Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the September meeting of the Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the agency, board, commission, or institution and the amount of funding carried forward, the program name or line item and the funding source; and
- (2) The State Military Department shall provide a written report to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee containing all information set forth in subdivision (b)(1) of this section no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Department presents its budget request to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, or both; and
- (3) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include all information obtained in subdivision (b)(2) of this section in the budget manuals.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020."

- (a)(1) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue fund to be known as the "Arkansas Wine Grants Fund".
 - (2) The Arkansas Wine Grants Fund shall consist of fees collected from grocery store wine permits under § 3-5-1802 and shall be administered by the Department of Finance and Administration.
- (b) Fifty percent (50%) of fees that are deposited into the Arkansas Wine Grants Fund under § 3-5-1802 shall be divided among the wineries seeking grant payments under § 3-5-901 et seq., according to the same ratio as the wine taxes paid in the previous calendar year by the grantee as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, not to exceed the amount paid in by each grantee.
- (c) Fifty percent (50%) of fees that are deposited into the Arkansas Wine Grants Fund under § 3-5-1802 shall be transferred to the Tourism Development Trust Fund for the purpose of land acquisition, construction, lease, equipment acquisition, improvements, renovation, major maintenance, personal services, maintenance, operating and

staffing a wine tourism facility and office space for the Arkansas Wine Producers Council within the tourism facility in Franklin County, Arkansas.

(d) Any funds not obligated unused or undesignated fees at the end of the fiscal year shall be transferred to the Tourism Development Trust Fund."
