16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
21 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
22 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
23 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
24 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
25 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 46, Subchapter 3, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

20-46-316. Funding report.

(a) On or before April 30, July 31, October 31, and January 31, of each year, the Department of Human Services shall report the following data to the Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee during a regular, fiscal, or extraordinary session:

(1) A list of community mental health centers that are budgeted to receive funding from the State of Arkansas;

(2) The total annual amount of general revenue budgeted by the department for the current fiscal year of the reporting period;

(3) The total annual amount of general revenue distributed in the previous fiscal year to each community mental health center;

(4) The amount of state funding distributed each reporting quarter, budgeted fiscal year to date, and total projected for the fiscal year to each community mental health center;

(5) The amount of federal funding distributed each reporting quarter, budgeted fiscal year to date, and total projected for the fiscal year to each community mental health center; and

(6) The amount of other funding, listed by funding source, individually distributed each reporting quarter, budgeted fiscal year to date, and total projected for the fiscal year to each community mental health center.

(b) Each quarterly report shall cover the immediate preceding calendar quarter and appropriate fiscal year.

2 For employees hired on or after July 1, 2013, at the Arkansas State
3 Hospital in the classifications listed above, the Division of Aging, Adult,
4 and Behavioral Health Services Director shall set the number of work days for
5 the employment year to equal the number of days worked by those employed in
6 the same classifications at the Arkansas Schools for the Blind and Deaf. The
7 accrual, use, and carryover of sick days, personal days, and holidays of the
8 employees at the Arkansas State Hospital that are hired on or after July 1,
9 2013, or current employees choosing to adopt this plan, shall be treated in
10 the same manner as those employed in the same classifications at the Arkansas
11 Schools for the Blind and Deaf.

12 Those currently employed at the Arkansas State Hospital in the
13 classifications listed above as of June 30, 2013, have the one-time option of
14 adopting this language or continuing to operate under the same salary, leave
15 and benefit plans they are currently receiving. Employees must make their
16 decision by June 30, 2013.

17 Accrued annual and holiday leave, up to 240 hours, as of June 30,
18 2013, will be paid out to current employees choosing to adopt this plan. Any
19 additional accrued annual and holiday leave will be forfeited. Accrued sick
20 leave, as of June 30, 2013, shall be retained on file and shall be exhausted
21 before any newly accrued sick leave may be taken.

22 All employees affected by this section shall be eligible to receive
23 hazardous duty pay for time worked in eligible areas.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2018~~

" SECTION 47. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OLMSTEAD FEE PAYMENT RESTRICTION AND REPORTING REQUIREMENT. (i) Funds appropriated by this Act, fund balances or any funding sources of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall not be utilized to pay, reimburse, pay administrative charges or pay any fees to another State agency for the State's Olmstead plan or for any State agency's processing or administration of State match funds received as reimbursement funding for federal financial participation under the Medicaid's Disproportionate Share (DSH) reimbursement program.

(ii) For Fiscal Year 2020 and thereafter, the Department of Human Services shall provide the services for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences as in previous fiscal years for the State Olmstead plan and for processing or administration of State match funds charges as reimbursement funding for federal financial participation under the Medicaid's Disproportionate Share (DSH) reimbursement program.

(iii) The Department of Human Services shall charge the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences an administrative fee percentage for Medicaid supplemental payments that is less than or equal to other participating entities, including Arkansas Children's Hospital.

(iv) The Department of Human Services shall submit a report by May 31 of each year for certification by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to ensure the Department of Human Services follows the requirements of this Section, which shall include the administrative charges or fees which the Department of Human Services has charged to all participating entities, including the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, for Medicaid supplemental payments for the last completed fiscal year, including the amounts and administrative fee percentage. The report shall also include the

projected administrative charges or fees which the Department of Human Services will charge to all participating entities for Medicaid supplemental payments for the next fiscal year, including the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, including the amounts and administrative fee percentage.
