I respectfully request the following amendment to SB9, the 2023-2024 Operations Appropriation Bill for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission.

Please insert SECTION XX. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - EXTRA HELP EXEMPTION as follows and renumber accordingly:

SECTION XX. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. EXTRA HELP EXEMPTION. The Arkansas Public Defender Commission may utilize their authorized extra help positions up to a maximum of one thousand eight hundred (1,800) hours. The rates of pay may not exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification Act or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

This will allow the Commission to utilize Extra Help employees, assisting with case baklog, beyond the existing 1,500 hour limitation.

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2023-2024
FISCAL YEAR.
Amendment No to Senate Bill No. 9
Amend Senate Bill No. 9 as originally introduced:
Page 9, immediately following SECTION 19, insert a new SECTION to read as follows:
" SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP EXEMPTION. The Arkansas Public Defender Commission may utilize their authorized extra help positions up to a maximum of one thousand eight hundred (1,800) hours. The rates of pay may not exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification Act or its successor, for the appropriate classification. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024."
Appropriately renumber the subsequent SECTION numbers of the bill.
