Amend House Bill No. 1220 as engrossed H3/3/21 (version: 3/3/2021 2:16:14 PM):

Insert an additional SECTION immediately following SECTION 29 to read as follows:

" SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS FUND TRANSFER. From time to time, the Secretary of the Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism may instruct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer on his or her books, and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State, such amounts as determined by the Secretary from the Arkansas Division of Heritage Special Fund Account to a sub-fund within the Arkansas Cultural Institutions Trust Fund to make grants for major capital improvement projects at Arkansas cultural institutions. For any unobligated balances identified by the department, the Secretary may instruct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer on his or her books, and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State, the unobligated sub-fund balances in the Arkansas Cultural Institutions Trust Fund to the Arkansas Division of Heritage Special Fund Account.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022."

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20 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - SAVE THE CHILDREN. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable from the Division
22 of Elementary and Secondary Education Fund Account, the following:

23 (A) for a grant for statewide in-school, summer, and after school
24 literacy, nutrition, home visiting and early childhood programs to be
25 administered by Save the Children for low income, at-risk children of the
26 Department of Education - Division of Elementary and Secondary Education -
27 Save the Children, in a sum not to exceed
28\$500,000.
29

30 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
31 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
32 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
33 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by



1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3

4 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
6 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
7 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12

13 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
19 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm
20 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
21 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
22 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
23 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.

Amend House Bill No. 1219 as originally introduced:

Page 13, delete line 11 in its entirety and substitute the following:

"COLLEGE/ANC _____ 1,475,000"

AND

Page 13, line 12, delete "\$1,802,870" and substitute "\$1,827,870"

AND

Page 25, immediately following SECTION 54, insert a new SECTION to read as follows:

" SECTION 55. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 17-24-305(b), concerning licensing fees and the disposition of licensing fees by the State Board of Collection Agencies, is amended to read as follows:
(b)(1) All income from fees imposed under this section shall be distributed in the form of one (1) annual payment that is a percentage of the total funds available up to the maximum authorized under this subsection.

(2) However, if less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total allocation is available for distribution, all allocations listed in subdivisions (b)(3)(A)-~~(H)~~ (I) of this section shall be funded at a prorated percentage consistent with the available funds, not to exceed the maximum amounts listed in subdivisions (b)(3)(A)-~~(H)~~ (I) of this section.

(3) Beginning July 1, 2013, and each fiscal year thereafter, the board shall remit to:

(A) The Treasurer of State for the Division of Medical Services of the Department of Human Services, an amount not to exceed one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000) for deposit into a paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to be used in accordance with § 20-10-705;

(B) The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, an amount not to exceed six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for deposit into a financial institution in accordance with the policies of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to be expended for the College of Pharmacy of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and the College of Nursing of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in accordance with § 6-64-417;

(C) Arkansas State University-Mountain Home, an amount not to exceed two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for deposit into the Arkansas State University-Mountain Home Fund to be expended exclusively for the Arkansas State University-Mountain Home Practical Nursing Program;

(D) The University of Central Arkansas, an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for deposit into the University of Central Arkansas Fund to be expended exclusively for the University of Central Arkansas School of Nursing;

(E) Southern Arkansas University, an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for deposit into the Southern Arkansas University Fund to be expended exclusively for personal services and operating expenses of the Southern Arkansas University system;

(F) Henderson State University, an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for deposit into the Henderson State University Fund;

(G) Arkansas Tech University, an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for deposit into the Arkansas Tech University Fund exclusively for nursing programs; ~~and~~

(H) Northwest Arkansas Community College, an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for deposit into the Northwest Arkansas Community College Fund exclusively for nursing programs; ~~and~~

(I) Arkansas Northeastern College, an amount not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for deposit into the Arkansas Northeastern College Fund to be expended exclusively for nursing programs.

(4) Funds remaining after the distributions listed in subdivisions (b)(3)(A)-(H) ~~(I)~~ of this section shall be deposited into a bank authorized to do business within this state and placed into the account of the board."
